Transmission Symptom - Scraping Noises when Changing from 1st to 2nd Gear (SY 167/21)

Vehicle Type: **718 Spyder (982)/718 Cayman GT4 (982)**

- Model Year: As of 2019
- Equipment: 6-speed manual transmission (M-no. 480)
- Concerns: Manual transmission
- Symptom: A customer complains about a scraping noise when changing from 1st to 2nd gear.
- Cause: For performance reasons, no shifting mass was installed on the manual transmission on 718 Spyder (982) and 718 GT4 (982) vehicles, e.g. to achieve sportier gearshifts. As a result, under unfavourable conditions such as:
 - Cold transmission oil
 - High shifting speed
 - High engine speed

Noises can be heard when changing from 1st to 2nd gear.

Remedial Action:

Information

Replacing the manual transmission will not correct the problem because this is not a manual transmission fault.



Please note that retrofitting the balancing weight changes the vehicle's shift feel. As a result, shifting can then be perceived as less sporty than before and is then comparable with the shift feel of the 718 Boxster/Cayman GTS 4.0 (982).

In the event of a complaint, a balancing weight can be retrofitted on the manual transmission.

On the 718 Spyder/Cayman GT4 (982), the shift feel was deliberately adapted to a sportier setup than on the 718 Boxster/Cayman GTS 4.0 (982).

Inform the customer about this before retrofitting the balancing weight.

Also inform the customer that retrofitting the balancing weight cannot be invoiced under the new vehicle warranty or PAW (Porsche Approved Warranty) as this is not a fault.

Preparatory work

Work Procedure: 1 Removing rear underbody cover. \Rightarrow Workshop Manual '519419 Removing and installing cover for rear underbody'

Retrofitting balancing weight

Work Procedure: 1 Position balancing weight on the transmission and tighten with fastening screw \Rightarrow Installation position of balancing weight -3-.

Tightening torque 30 Nm +5 Nm


2 Press reversing lever onto ball joints \Rightarrow *Installation position of balancing weight*-1- and \Rightarrow *Installation position of balancing weight*-2-.

After installing the reversing lever, check that it is installed securely and correctly.
