

Stock Wheel Sizes

The first important measurement on Porsche wheels is the bolt-pattern. It's **5x130mm** which means that no other wheels from any other make of cars out there will **ever** fit on a Porsche. So don't waste your time trying to find inexpensive wheels from a rice-car to put on your Porsche. Some of the early 4-bolt 924s can use Ford wheels, but I haven't messed around with that fitment, so no comments on that.

The following lists stock wheels that came on various model Porsche 944/951 cars.
