

Approved Transmission Oils

Filing: This bulletin is a reissue of PAG Technical Information, Group 3, #1/99 and supersedes all previous published information concerning transmission oil and ATF for 911 vehicles 1965-1998.

Vehicle Type: All 911 models / all 911 Turbo models and the 914/6 model

Transmission Type: Manual transmission: 901/.., 902/.., 905/.., 911/.., 914/.., 915/.., 925/.., 930/.., G50/.., G64/..
 Front-axle final drive: Z64/00
 Tiptronic transmission: A50/..

Model Year: 1965 to 1998 (W / 993)

Approval Status: July 1999

Concerns: Transmission oil and ATF for Porsche manual transmissions and "Tiptronic" automatic transmissions.

Transmission Oil Approval: MANUAL TRANSMISSION

According to the service approval valid until now, all multi-range transmission oils of SAE class 75W-90 with API grade GL5 or MIL specification MIL-L 2105 B (C and D new) were approved for the aforementioned manual transmissions from Porsche.

Studies have shown that not all of the multi-range transmission oils available on the market are suitable for the aforementioned Porsche manual transmissions without restrictions.

In order to ensure that the quality demands on the transmission oil are met, we recommend using the proprietary transmission oils approved for the 911 Carrera (996) for the aforementioned transmission types as well.

Important: From now on, only these proprietary transmission oils are approved for the manual transmissions G50/.. and G64/.. of the vehicle models 911 Carrera 2 / 4 (all 964 models), 911 Carrera (all 993 models) and 911 Turbo models as of MY 91 (see table on Page 2).

Transmission Oil Approval: The transmission oils approved specially for the Porsche manual transmission of the 911 Carrera (996) model can also be used retroactively for subsequent filling / oil changes for all Porsche models.

Information: With the manual transmission types 901/.., 902/.., 905/.., 911/.., 914/.., 915/.., 925/.. and 930/.., the transmission oil SAE 90 GL5 (MIL-L 2105 B) which was previously approved for these transmissions may continue to be used. This also applies to the rear-axle final drive of the Tiptronic transmission.

ATF Approval: **TIPTRONIC TRANSMISSION**

The Automatic Transmission Fluid (ATF) "Esso ATF LT 71141" – Porsche part No. 999.917.547.00 – approved specially for the Tiptronic transmission of the 911 Carrera (996) model is also suitable retroactively for subsequent filling / fluid changes for all Porsche models with Tiptronic transmission.
