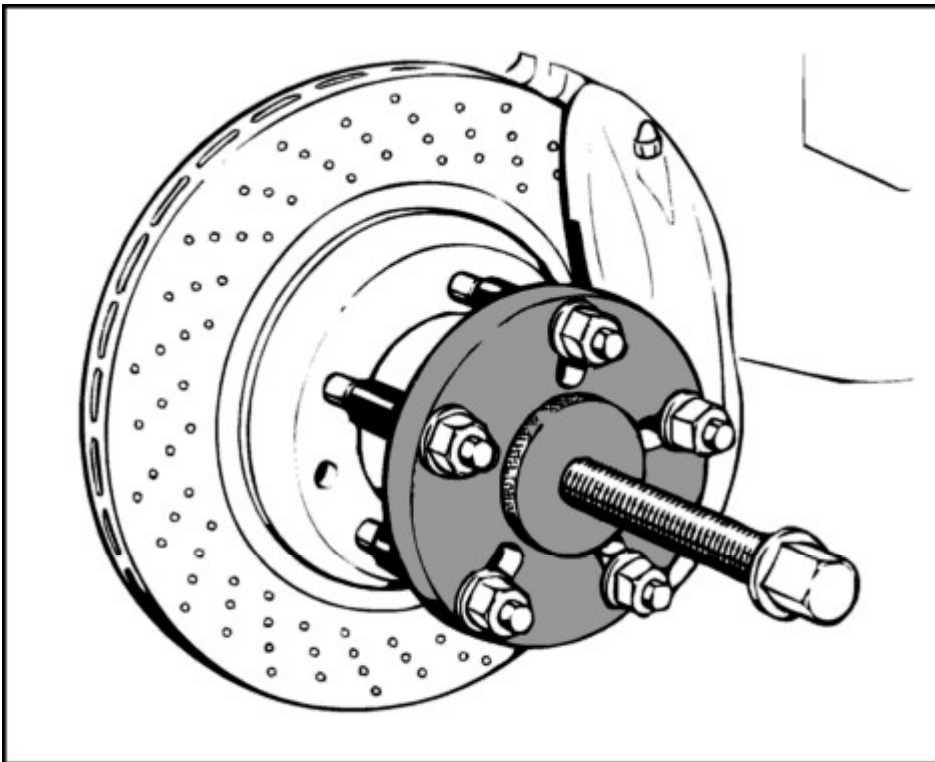


## 2006 Porsche Cayman S

2. Use **universal drive shaft/wheel hub extractor as of model '86 NR.87-1** to carefully press out the pin of the drive shaft until the shaft can be moved by hand. --> *Pressing out drive shaft* , See **Fig. 3**.
3. Remove (pull out) drive shaft.

### INSTALLING DRIVE SHAFT

#### Installing drive shaft

#### NOTE:

- **Screws are Dacromet-coated and must not be greased.**
- **Grease the tothing of the drive shaft lightly with Optimoly HT.**
- **To prevent damage to the drive shaft, slide a protective tube (shop-made) over the drive shaft.**
- **Use new screws and lock nuts.**
- **Observe correct tightening torques --> 420000 Tightening torques for rear axle.**
- **Always check the bellows for damage and replace them if necessary if you intend to continue using the drive shaft.**

1. Insert drive shaft and fit the axle nut.
