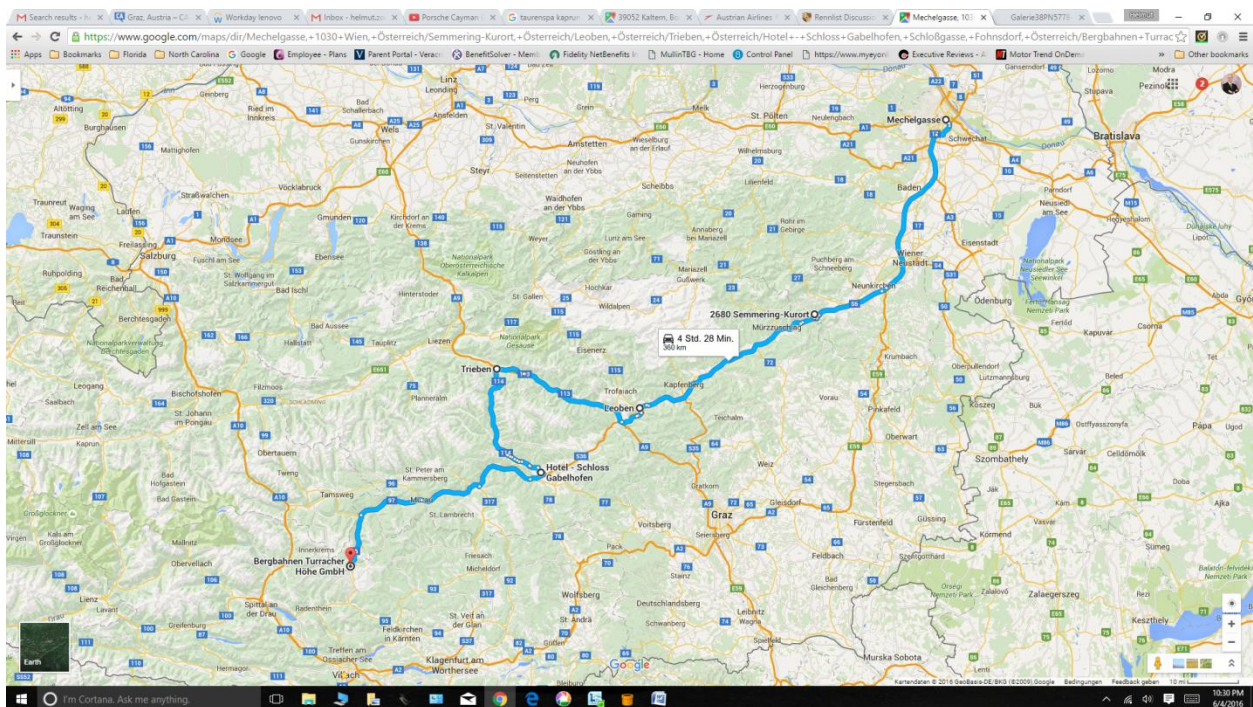
Impressions:



1st Day (approx. 5 hours driving time (370KM)) – Saturday July 2nd:

- **Vienna:** Starting early morning after a good breakfast and get on the highway for 1 hour
- **Gloggnitz:** Starting to hit the mountains and first stretch is the “Hoellental” – very narrow gorge
- **Semmering:** Old Spa town – source of the water in Vienna, getting off the highway
- **Leoben:** Steel Town – passing through
- **Trieben / Hohentauern:** Hitting some mountain roads and avoiding F1 traffic
- **Lunch:** Schloss Gabelhofen: Hotel Schloss Gabelhofen, Schloßgasse 54, 8753 Fohnsdorf, +43 (0)3573 - 5555-0
- **Turracher Höhe:** Climbing up the first high alpine road of the tour (Still today Audi Quattro and tire testing road – one of the steepest passes in the alps)

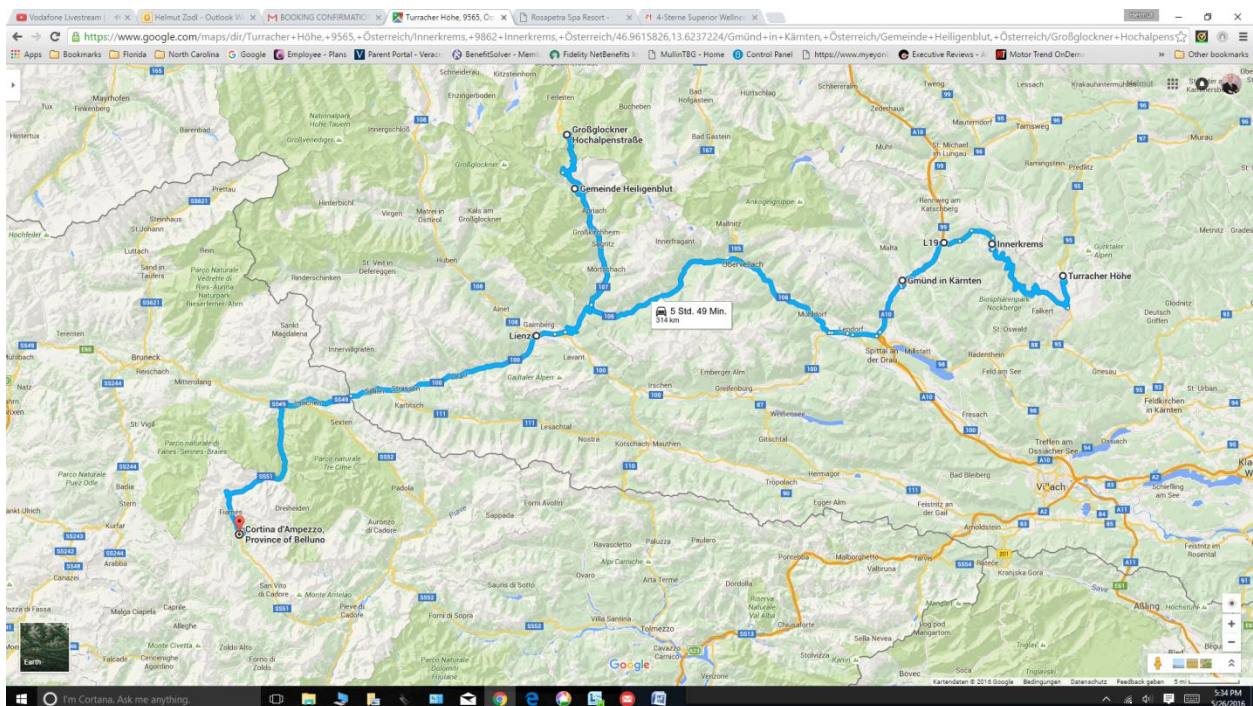

2nd Day (approx. 6 hours driving time (320 KM)) – Sunday July 3rd:

- **Turracher Hoeh**: Starting after a good (high altitude sleep) we will head down the Turracher Hoeh South
- **Innerkrems (Nockalmstrasse)**: Very close to the Hotel we will hit the first “Scenic Pass” – the Nockalmstrasse – the early testing ground of Porsche’s embedded in the rolling “Nocky Mountains”
- **Gmuend (Porsche Museum)**: Stopover in Gmuend to visit the small Porsche museum and the Porsche shed
- **Heiligenblut**: Picturesque town at the bottom of Grossglockner
- **Grossglockner**: Historic mountain pass and highest mountain in Austria very old alpine pass – we will head up the pass, enjoy the glacier and the highest spot of the road with a panoramic view of the Austrian high Alps as well as Zell am See in the North (expect to hit/see snow!)
- **Cortina d’Ampezzo**: Famous Italian Ski Resort town – site of Olympic Winter games and featured in 007 movies – checking in and enjoying the Rosapita Resort

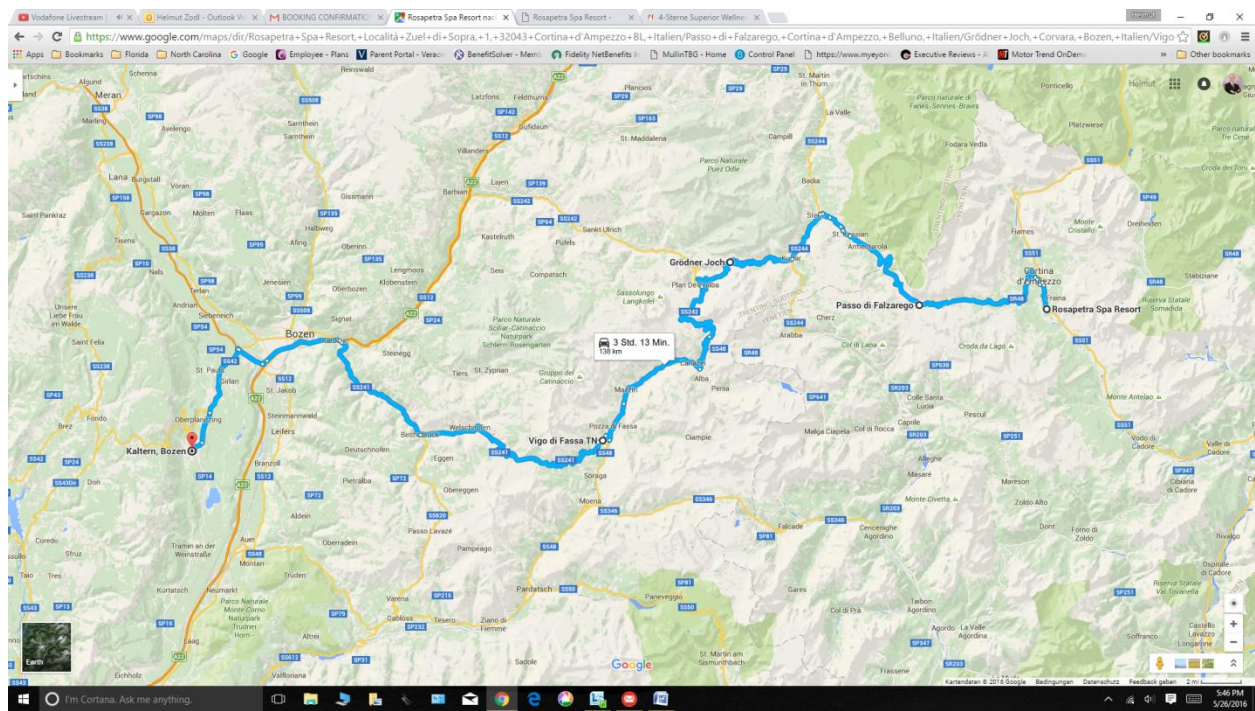

3rd Day: (4 hours driving time – (150 KM)) – July 4th:

- **Cortina D’Ampezzo:** Day 3 is our Dolomiti highlight with 4 wonderful passes for Breakfast – the picturesque mountains from the Dolomites differ from the Austrian Alpine mountains by its sharpness and steep walls
- **Passo di Falzarego:** – first up is Passo Falzarego - Passo die Falzarego was opened in 1909 and is still regarded as a technological masterpiece of road construction. From 1947 to 1956 the Falzarego Pass was part of the Coppa d’Oreo delle Dolomiti, one of Italy’s most grueling car races. It began at Cortina d’Ampezzo and traversed more than 300 kilometers through the spectacular mountains of the Dolomites.
- **Groedner & Sella & Pordojoch:** Already about 9000 years ago people were moving through this region but the stone age trekkers obviously did not take nature conservation very seriously as evidenced by the scattered animal bones and old flint stones – the remains of their prehistoric snacks. Through 17 tight hairpins – guaranteed to bring a smile to the face of every bend buff the road sweeps down steep and rocky walls for the murfeit towers – probably closest you will get to rock wall’s on this trip. Before leaving leaving the dolomites the the highest point in the alpine route of the dolomites – the 2.239 meters “Pordoi Joch” is being passed
- **Kaltern:** After a lot of turns and hairpins (130KM in more than 4 hours) we will arrive in Kaltern in the mid afternoon. Kaltern is a mid evil village that is famous for its Wine – very close to Tramin – since the 11th century wine is being cultivated in these villages

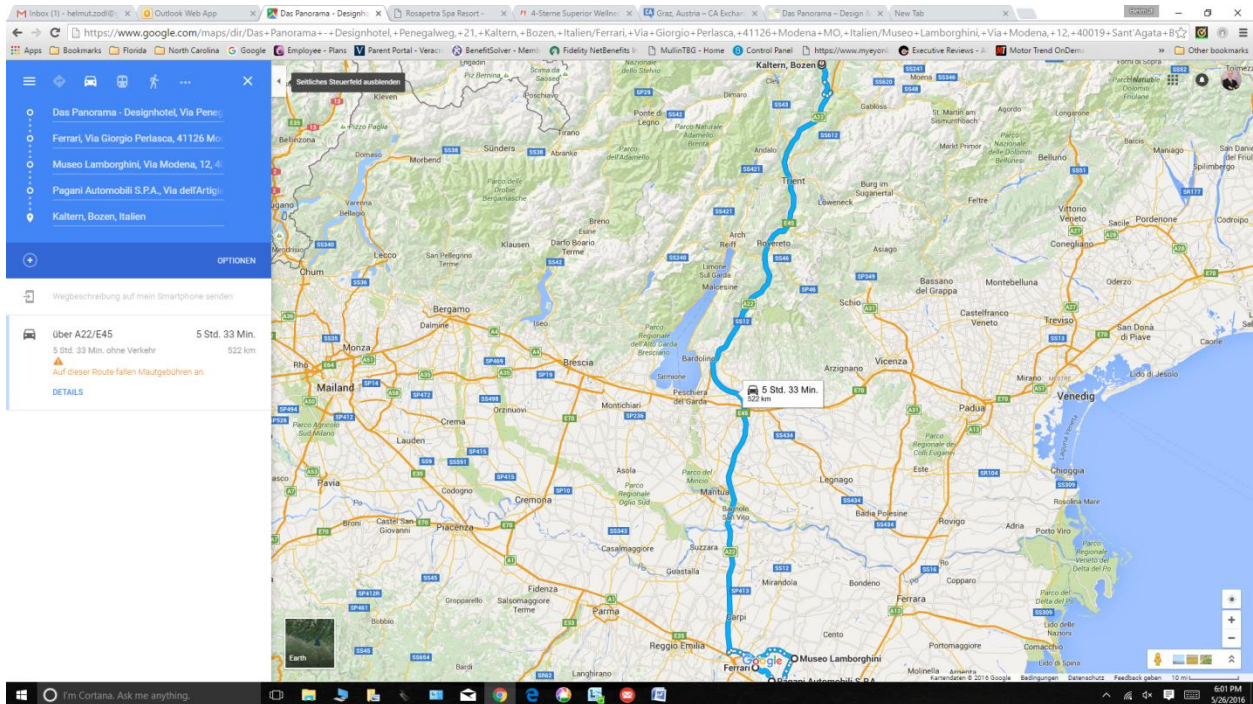


4th Day (6 hours driving time – 522 km) – July 5th:

- **Kaltern:** Early morning start to go on a 2.5 hours drive (highway drive) to Modena to visit

- **Modena – Lamborghini:** Visit of the Gallery and Factory Tour of the production line

- **Kaltern:** back to Kaltern and dinner either on the way or back in Kaltern

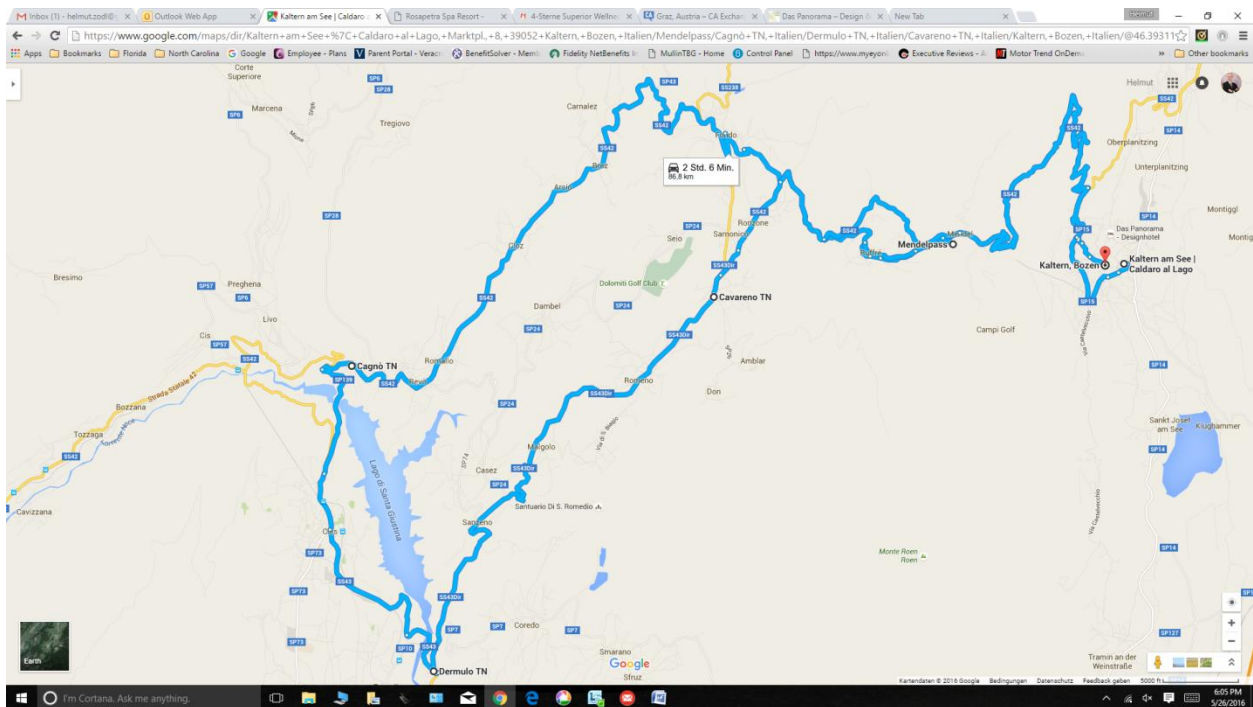

4th Day (alternative – short tour 2.5 hours (120KM)) – July 5th:

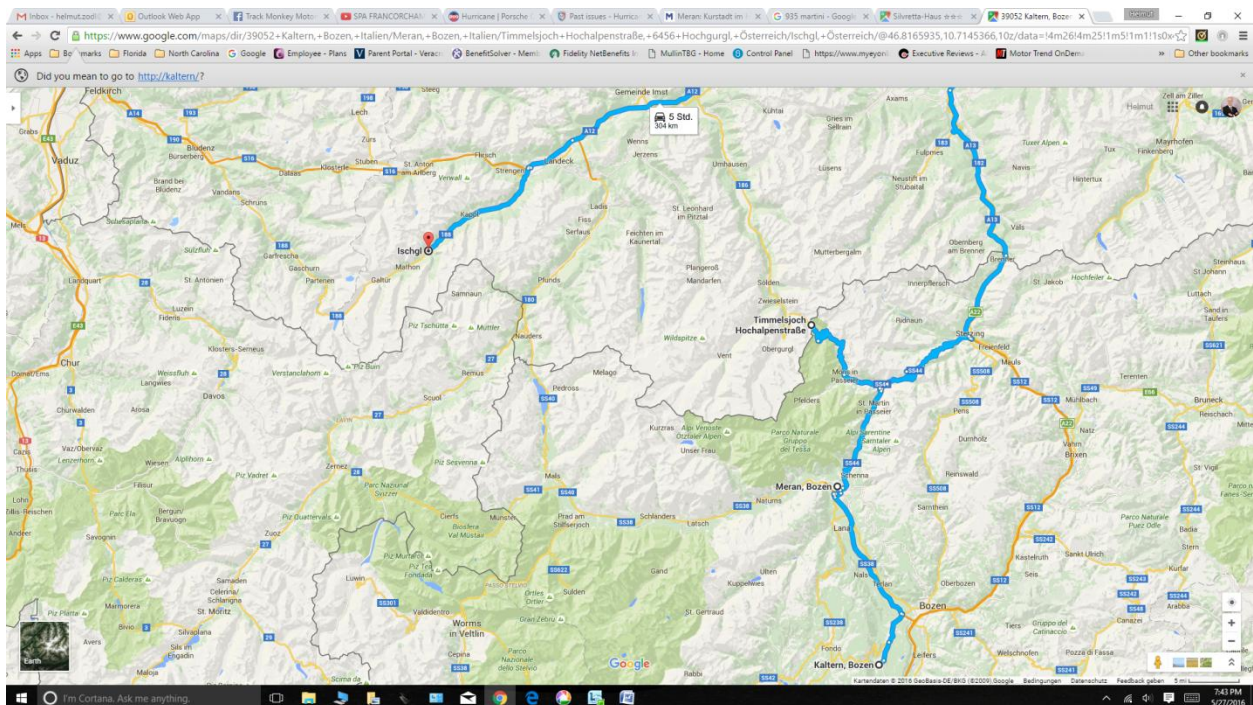
- **Kaltern:** Alternative to the Maranello Tour is a small (2.5 hours tour) of the mountains close to Kaltern toward Switzerland – pitoresque mountains and lake as well as gorge in Dermulo

5th Day (5 Hours drive time (300 KM)) – July 6th: (dropping Constantin off in Innsbruck):

- **Kaltern:** Early morning start heading up north back into Austria
- **Meran:** 2nd largest city in South Tyrol and worlds center of White Marble
- **Timmelsjoch (highest Pass in Austria):** Built almost 100 year's ago the Timmelsjoch is the highest mountain pass in Austria and over this pass as the story says Hannibal was crossing the alps – the pass is open for only about 3 month's a year (otherway's closed for snow)
- **Crosspoint:** Highest Motorcycle museum in Europe – great collection & some cars

- **Obergurgl** – famous Austrian skiing town with all year round skiing – we will stop over and have lunch

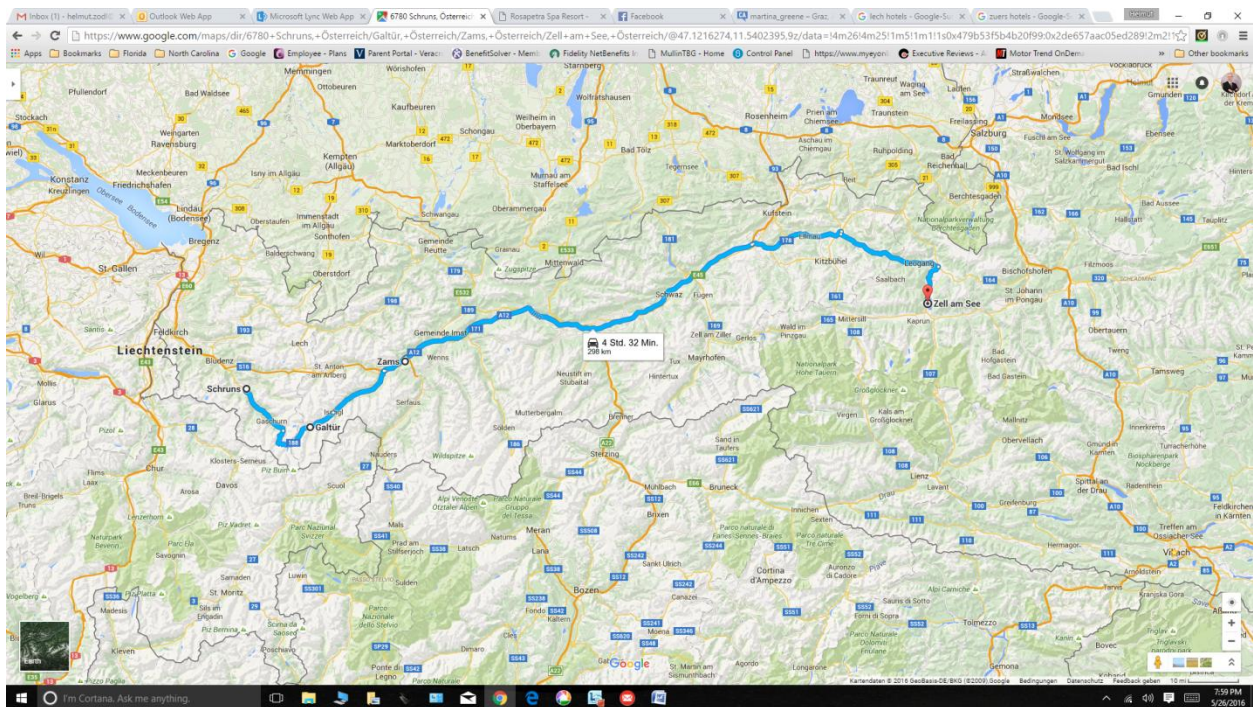

- **Kaprun:** checking into our hotel – Tauernspa in Kaprun – large spa hotel with hot springs

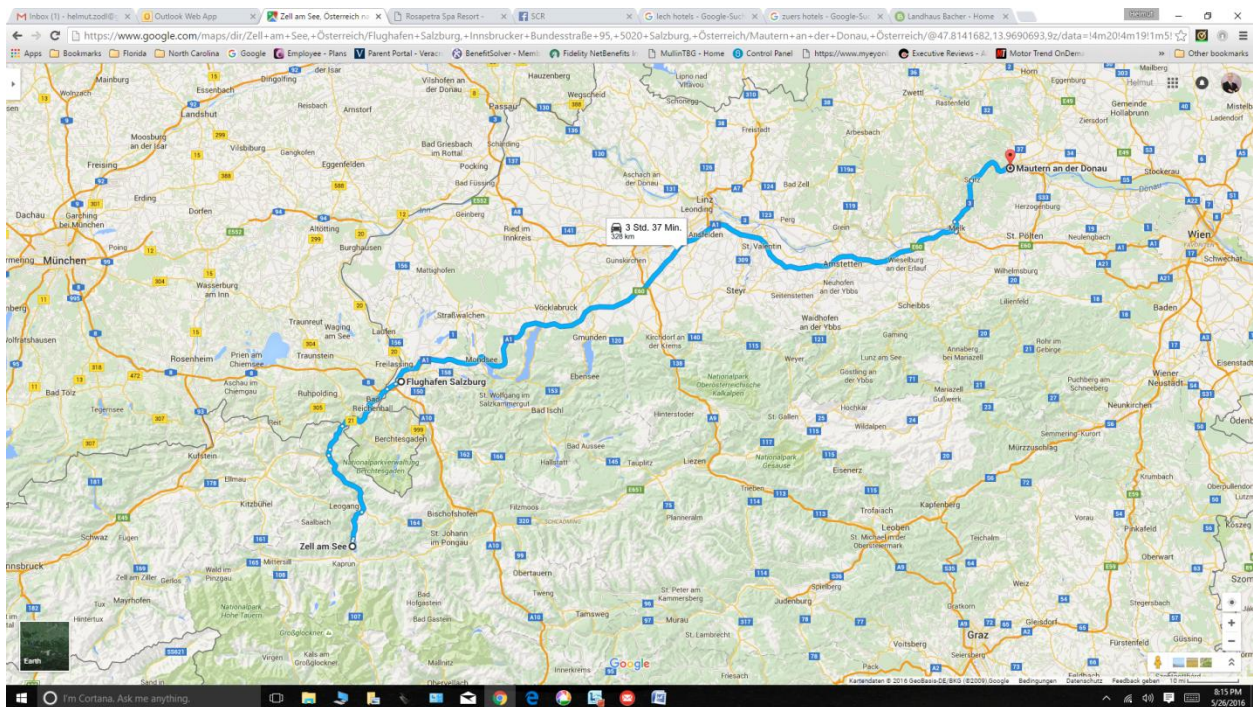
