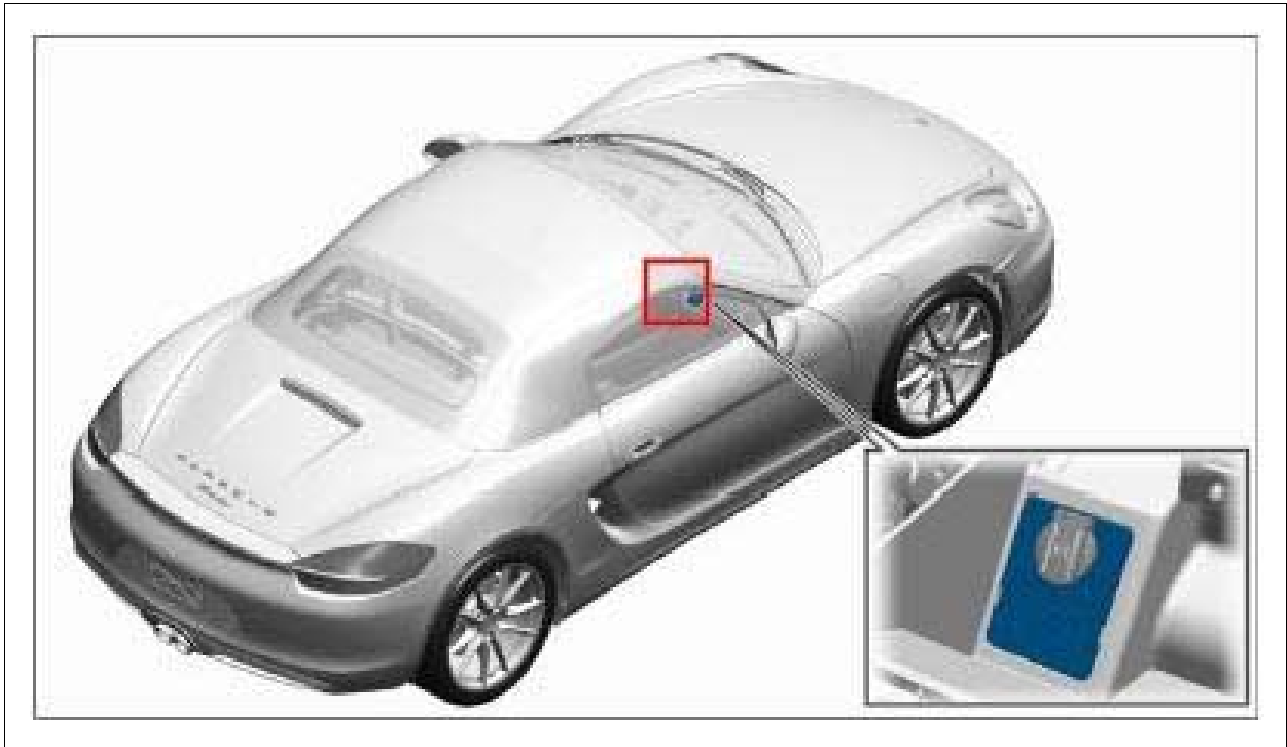


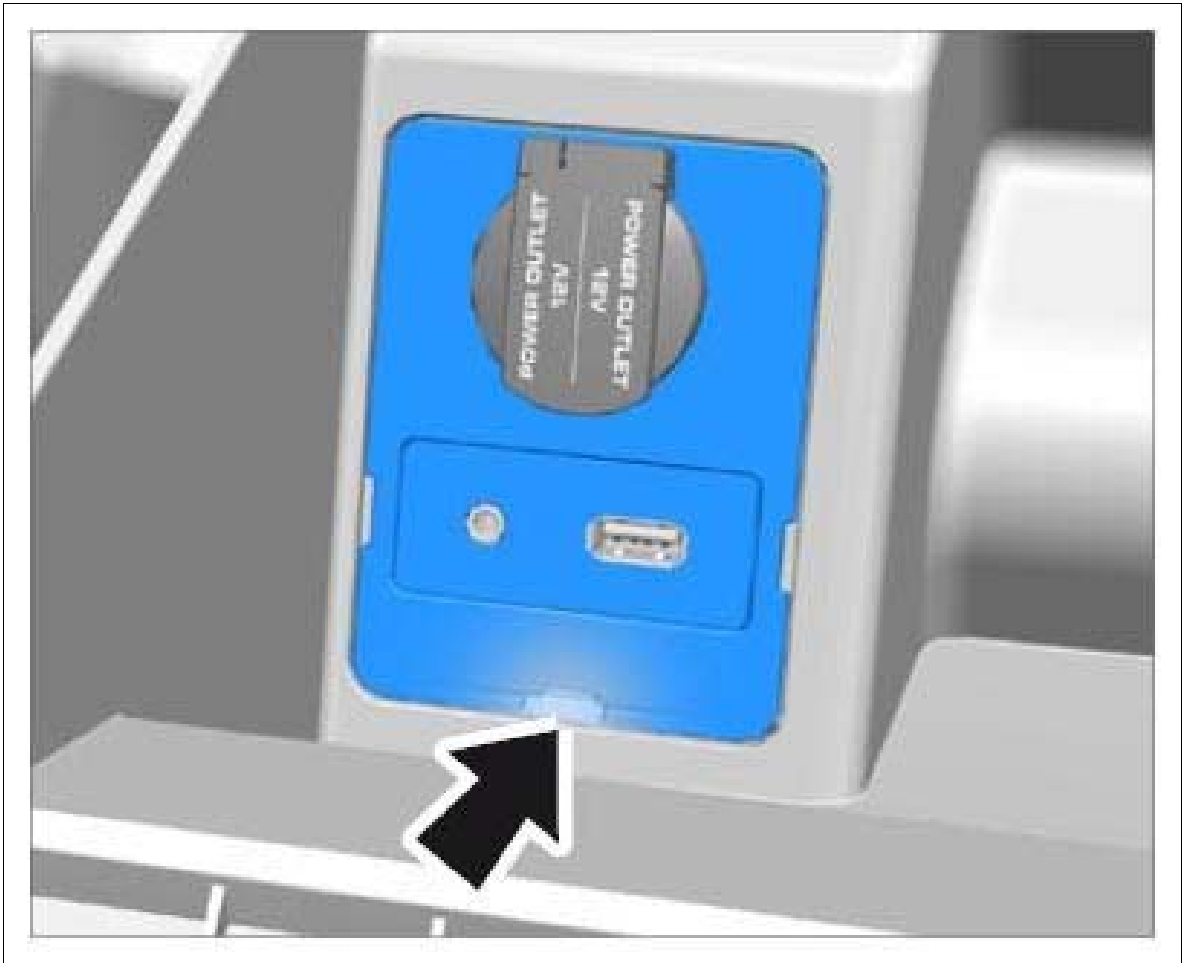
Fig 1: Identifying Multimedia Interface Position

Fig 2: Removing Multimedia Interface

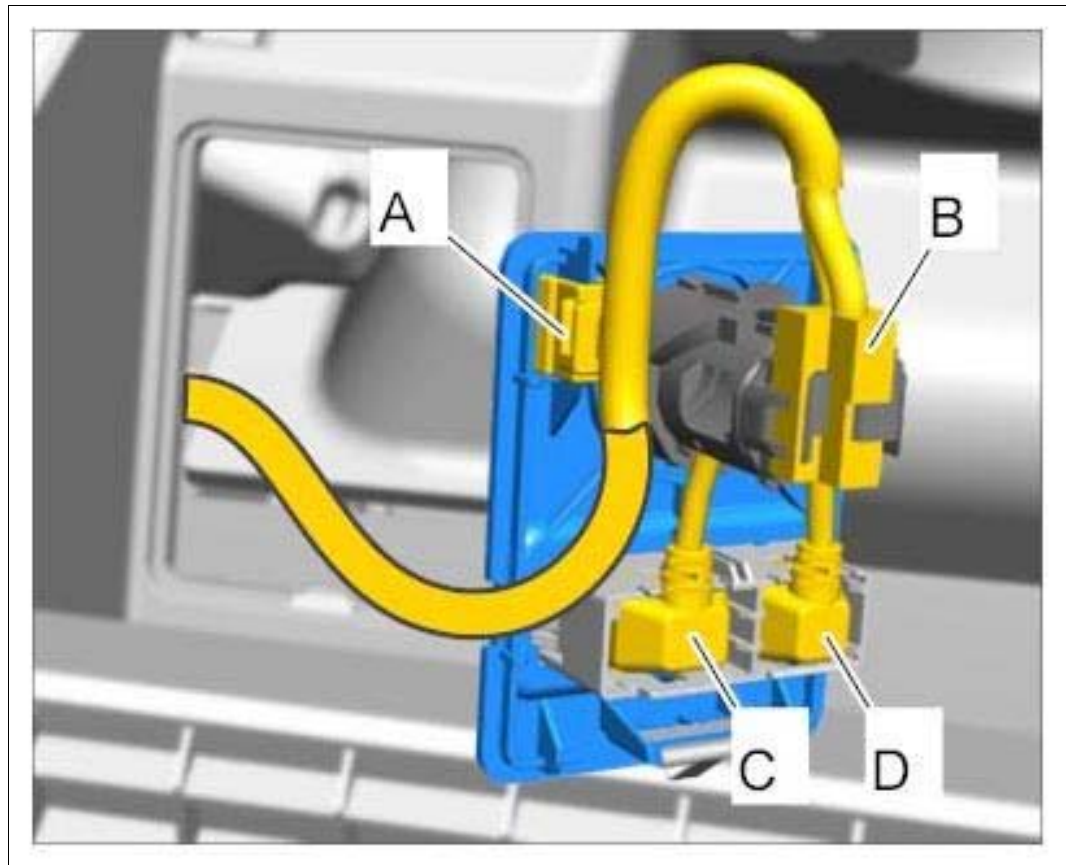

3. 2.3. Release mounting for USB interface **-C-** close to the locking lug and disconnect the USB interface.
4. 2.4. Release mounting for jack socket **-D-** close to the locking lug and disconnect jack socket.

Fig 3: Disconnecting Electric Plug Connections

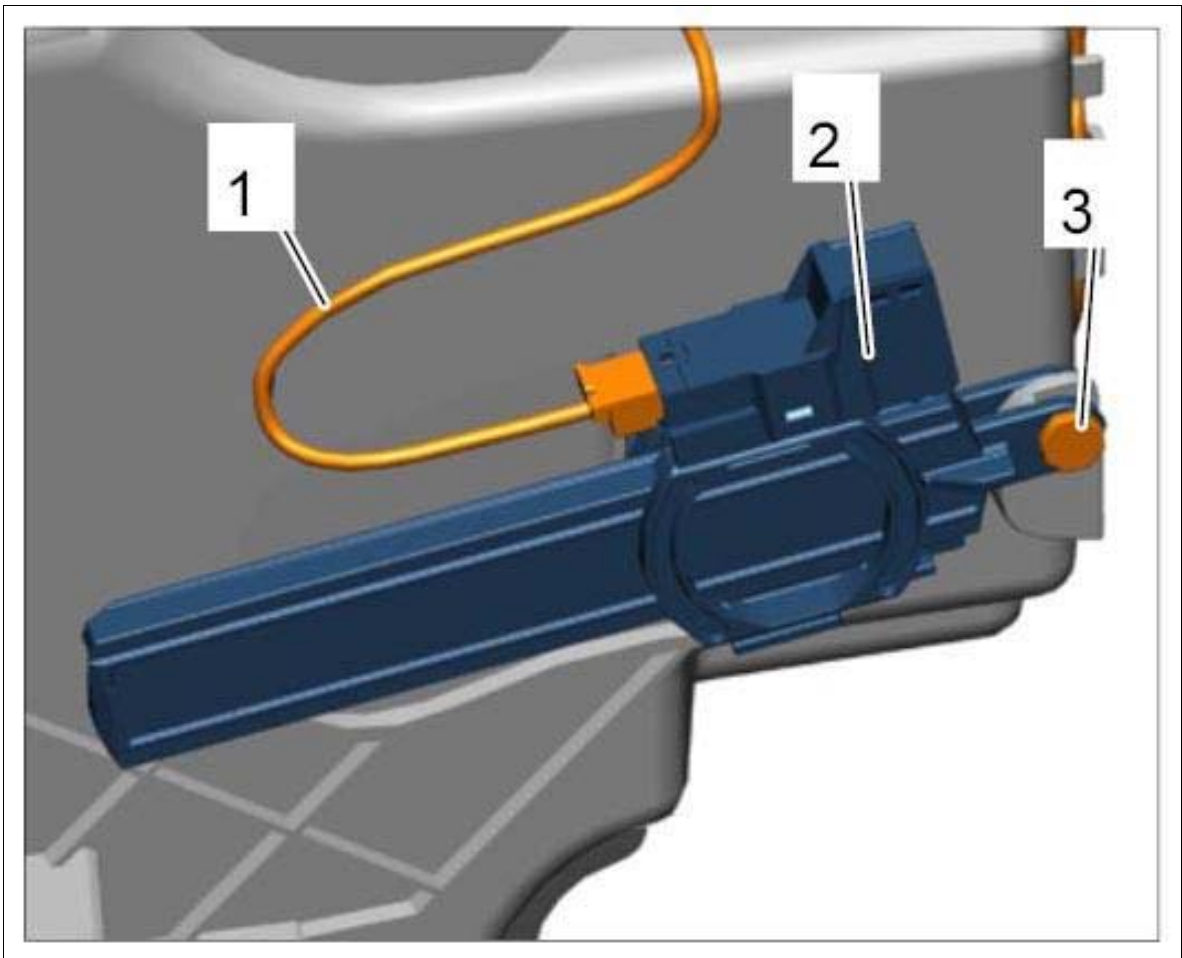

## WM 912219 REMOVING AND INSTALLING MULTIMEDIA INTERFACE (ALL MODELS) > INSTALLING MULTIMEDIA INTERFACE

1. Plug in electric plug connections for the multimedia interface.
  1. 1.1. Insert jack socket **-D-** into the mounting until the jack socket locks into place.
  2. 1.2. Insert USB interface **-C-** into the mounting until the USB interface locks into place.
  3. 1.3. Connect plug connection for 12 V supply **-B-** until the connector engages securely.
  4. 1.4. Secure the line with a tie-wrap **-A-** .

Fig 2: Securing Electric Plug Connection



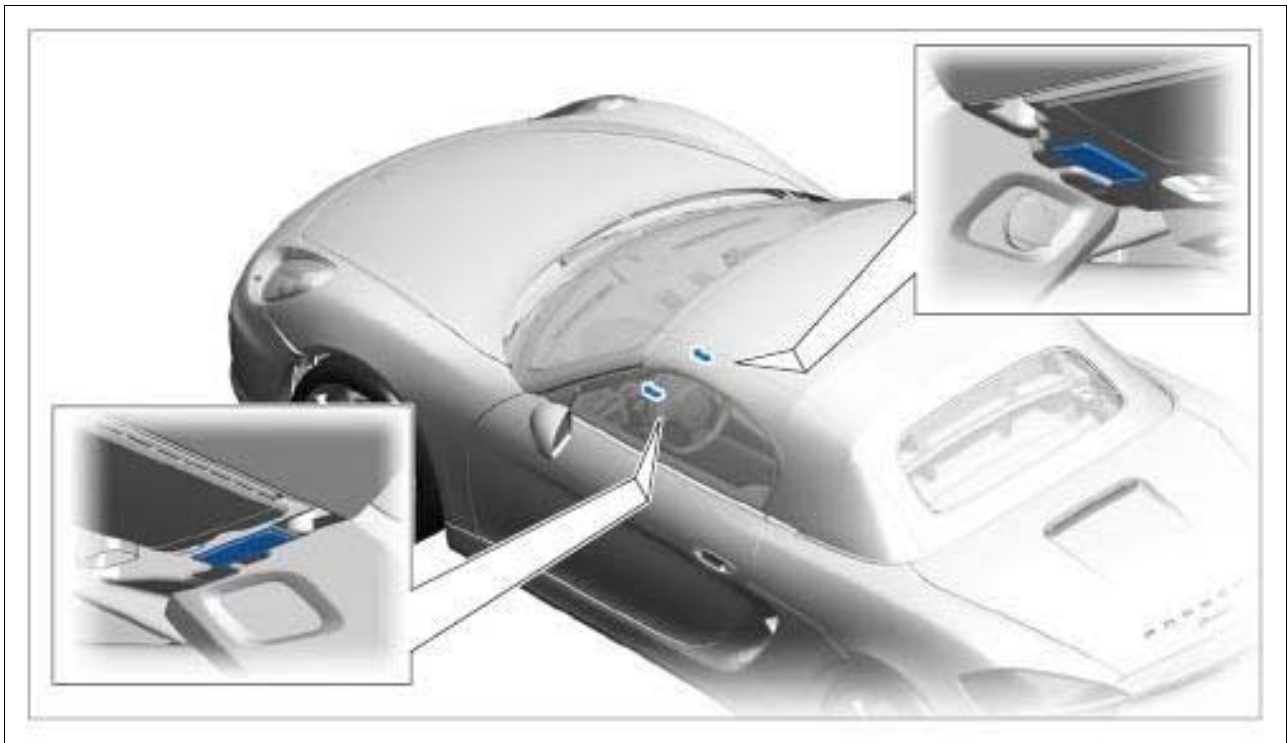

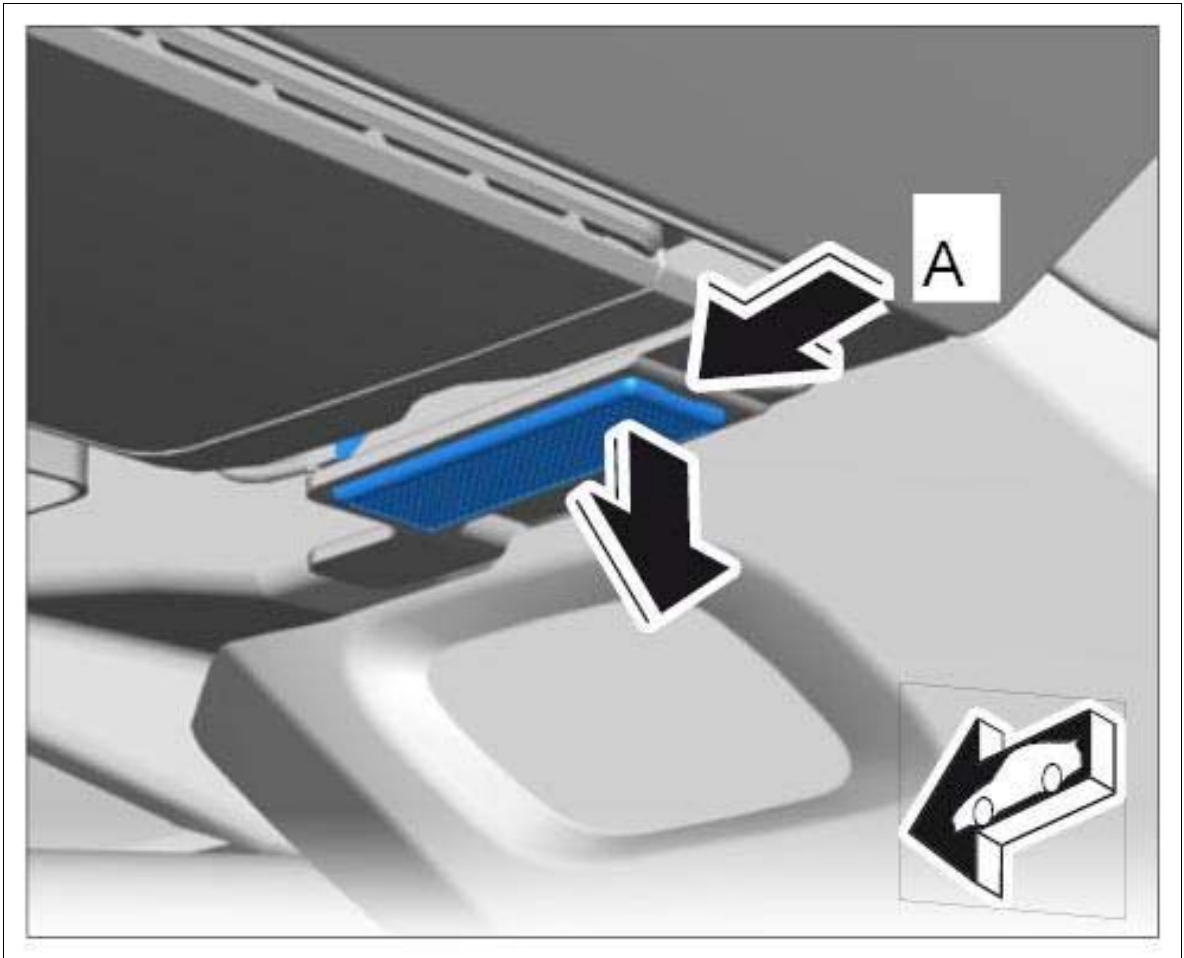
Fig 1: Identifying Footwell Lights Installation Position

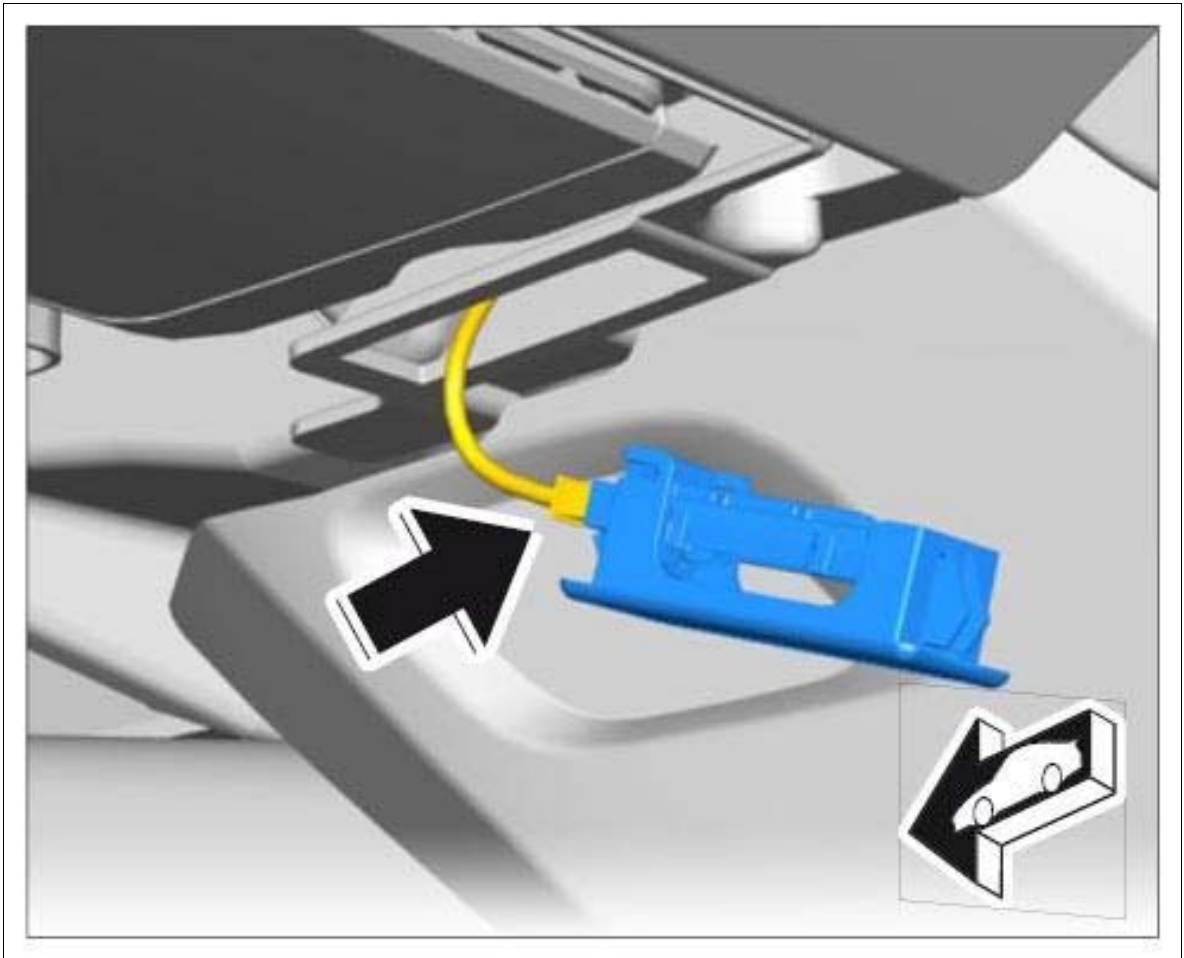
Fig 2: Unclipping Footwell Light

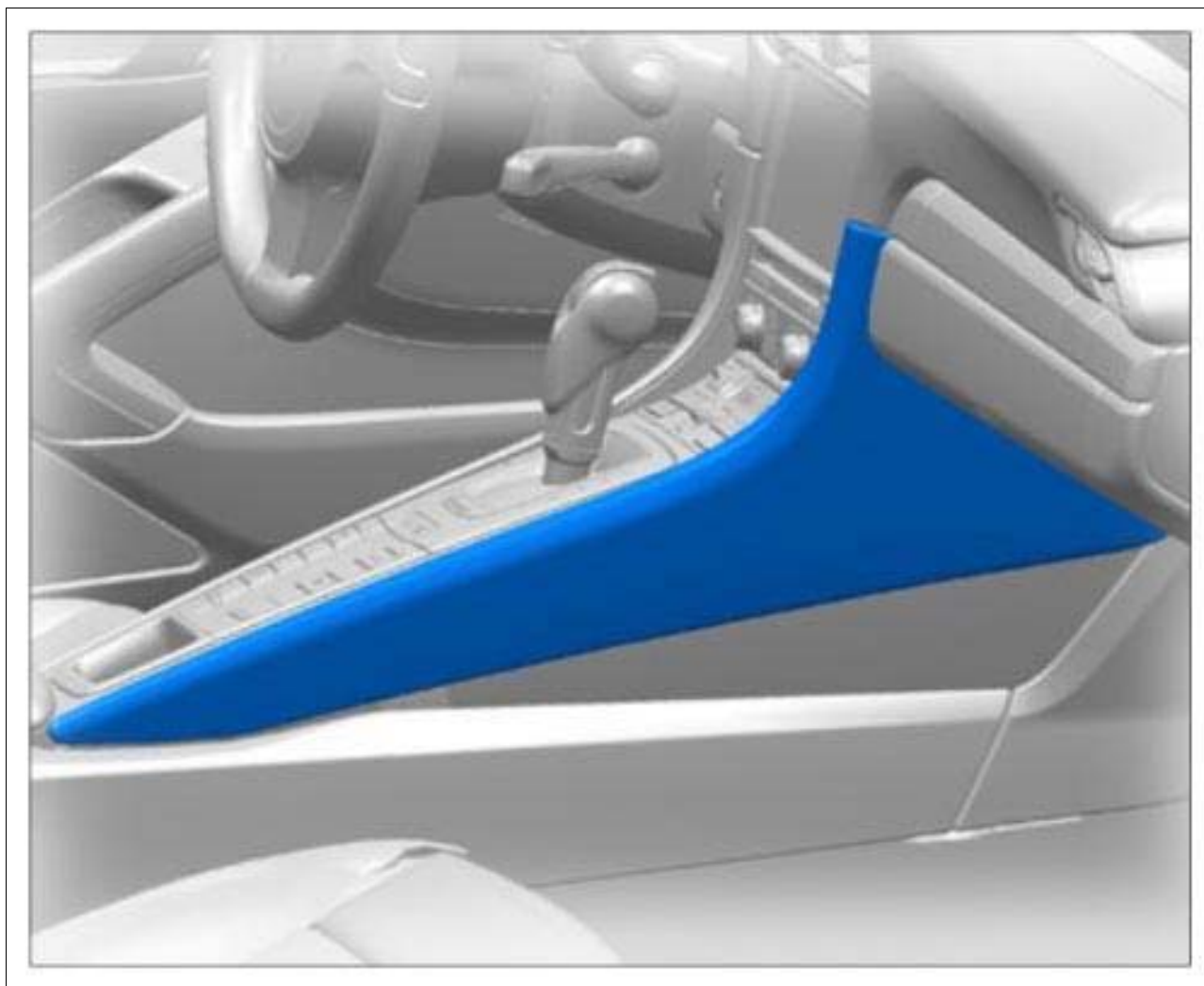

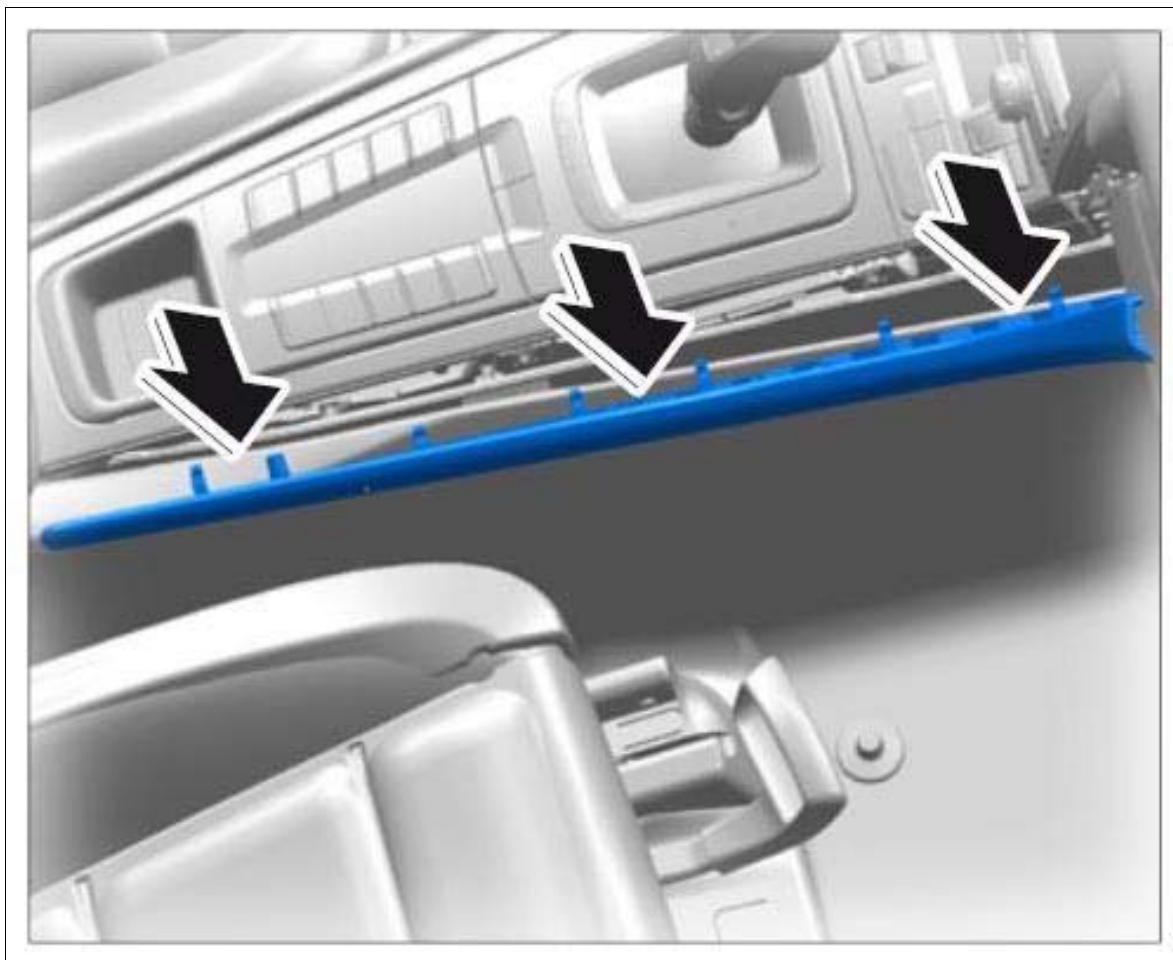

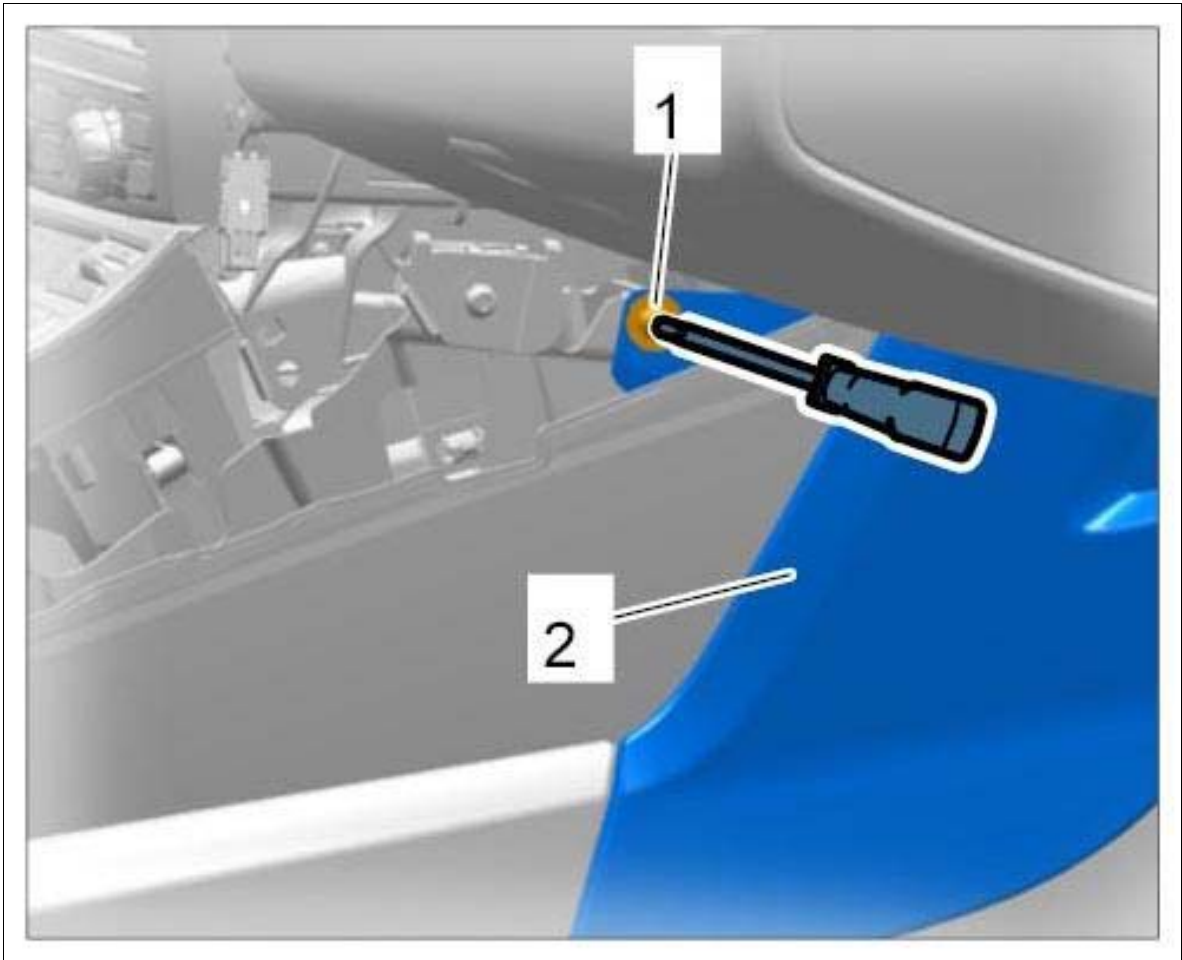
Fig 3: Removing Side Trim Panel

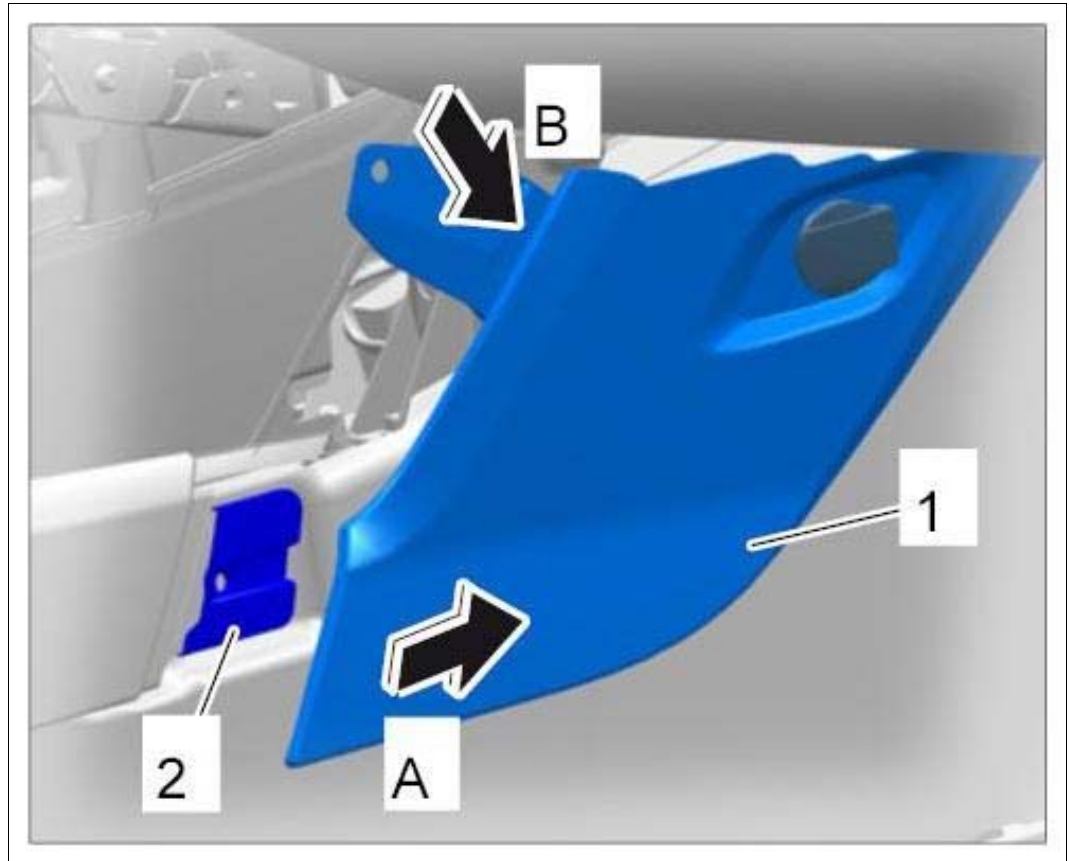

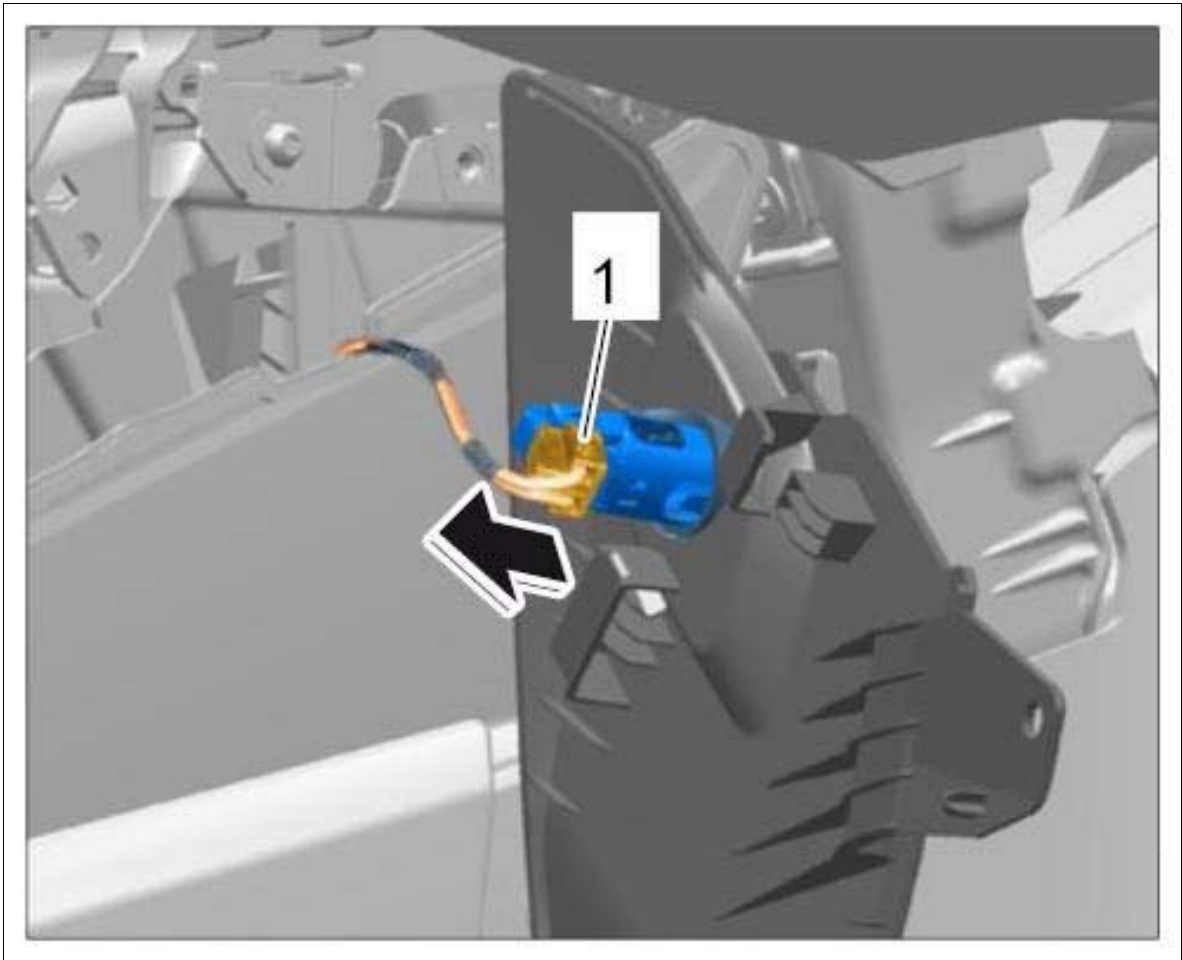
Fig 5: Removing Footwell Outlet Vent Trim

2. Tighten fastening screw on the footwell outlet vent trim to the specified tightening torque.

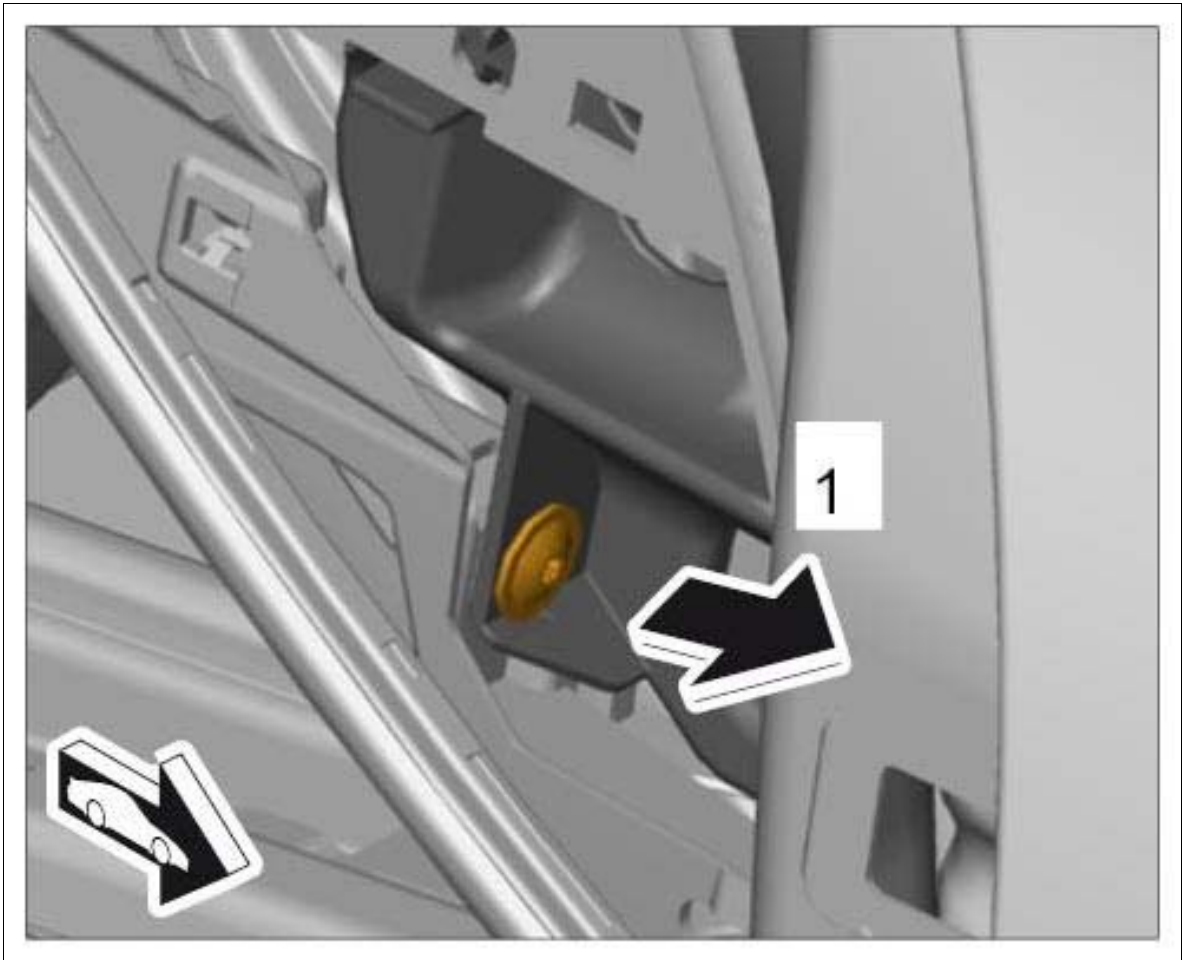

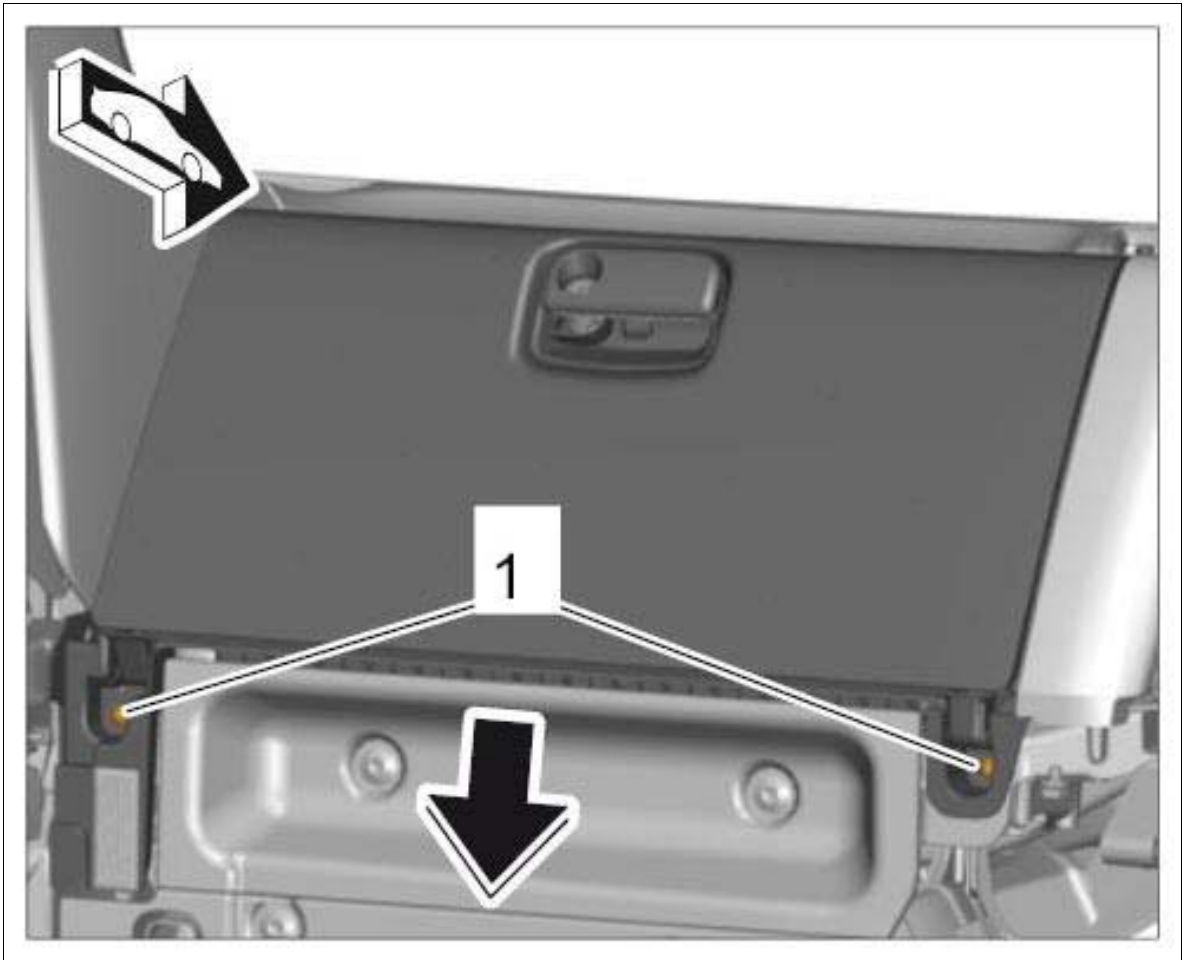
Fig 1: Loosening Mounting At Side

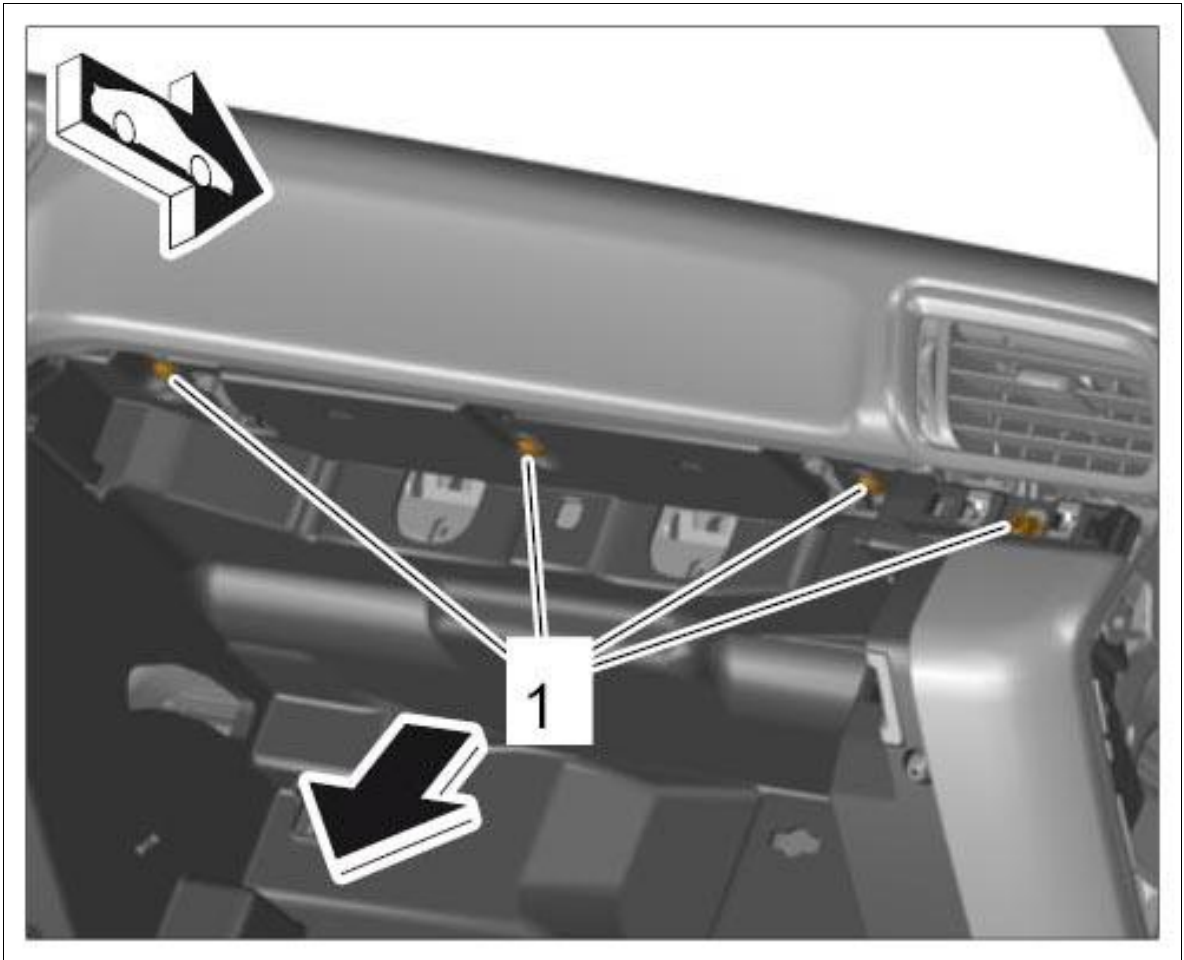

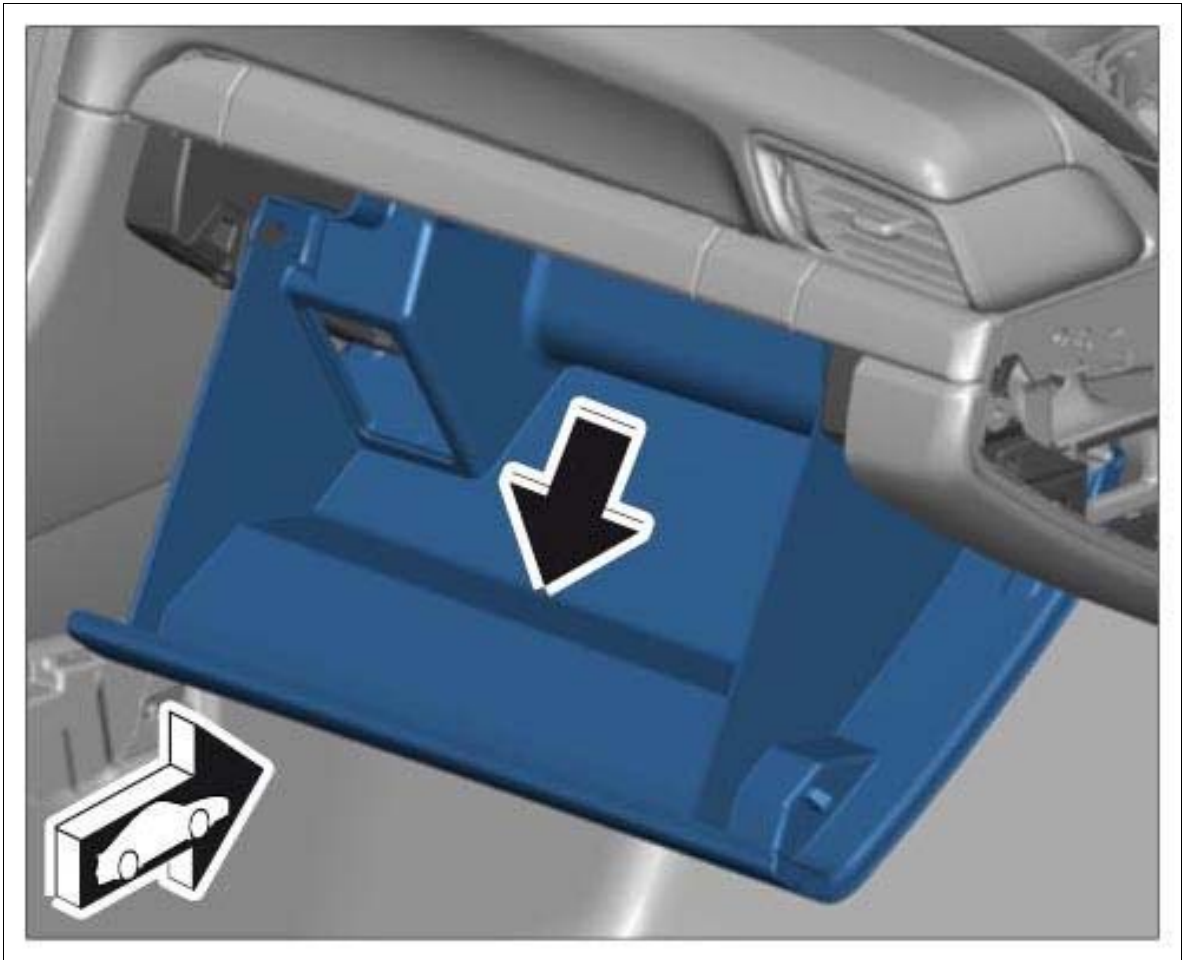
Fig 3: Loosening Mounting At Top

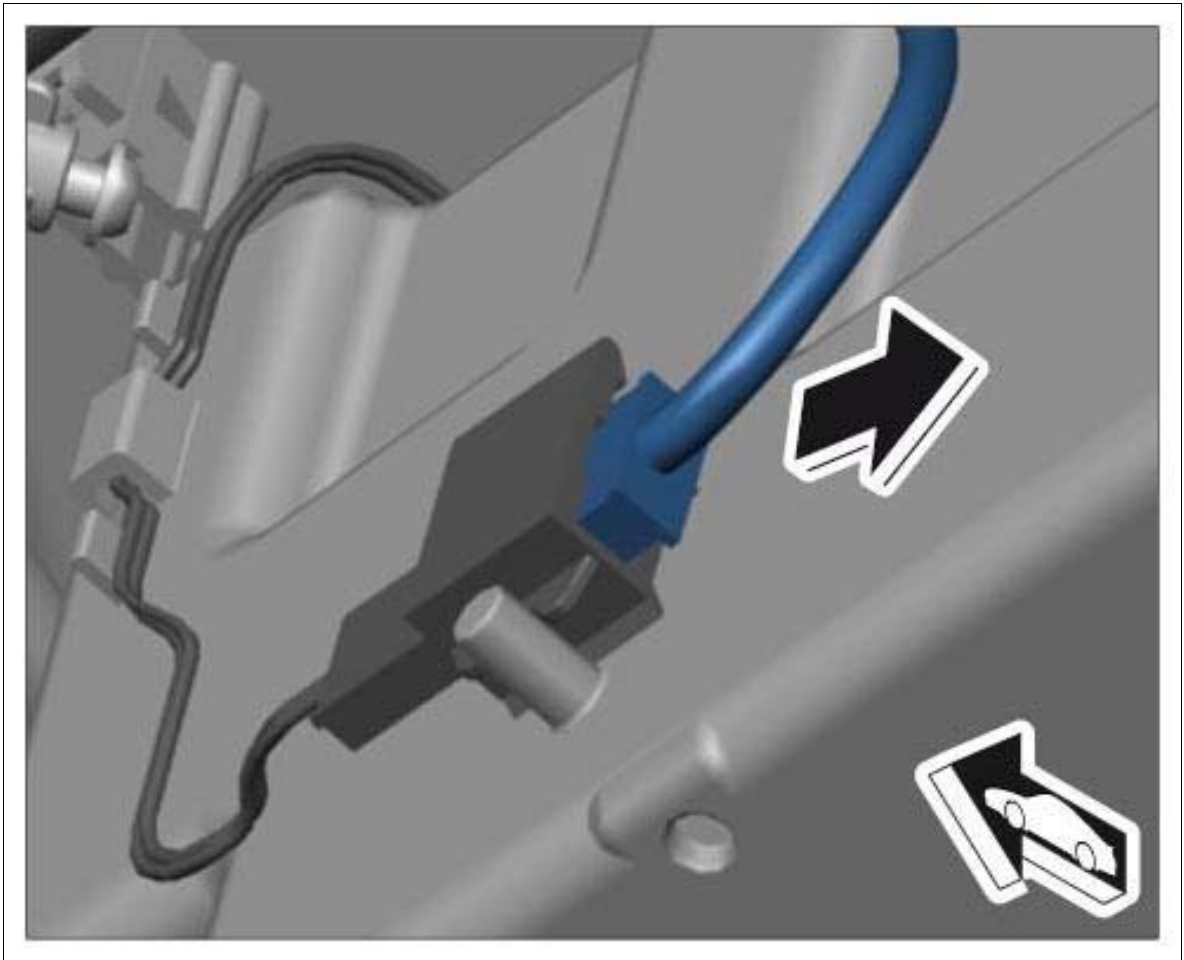
Fig 4: Unclipping Glove Compartment

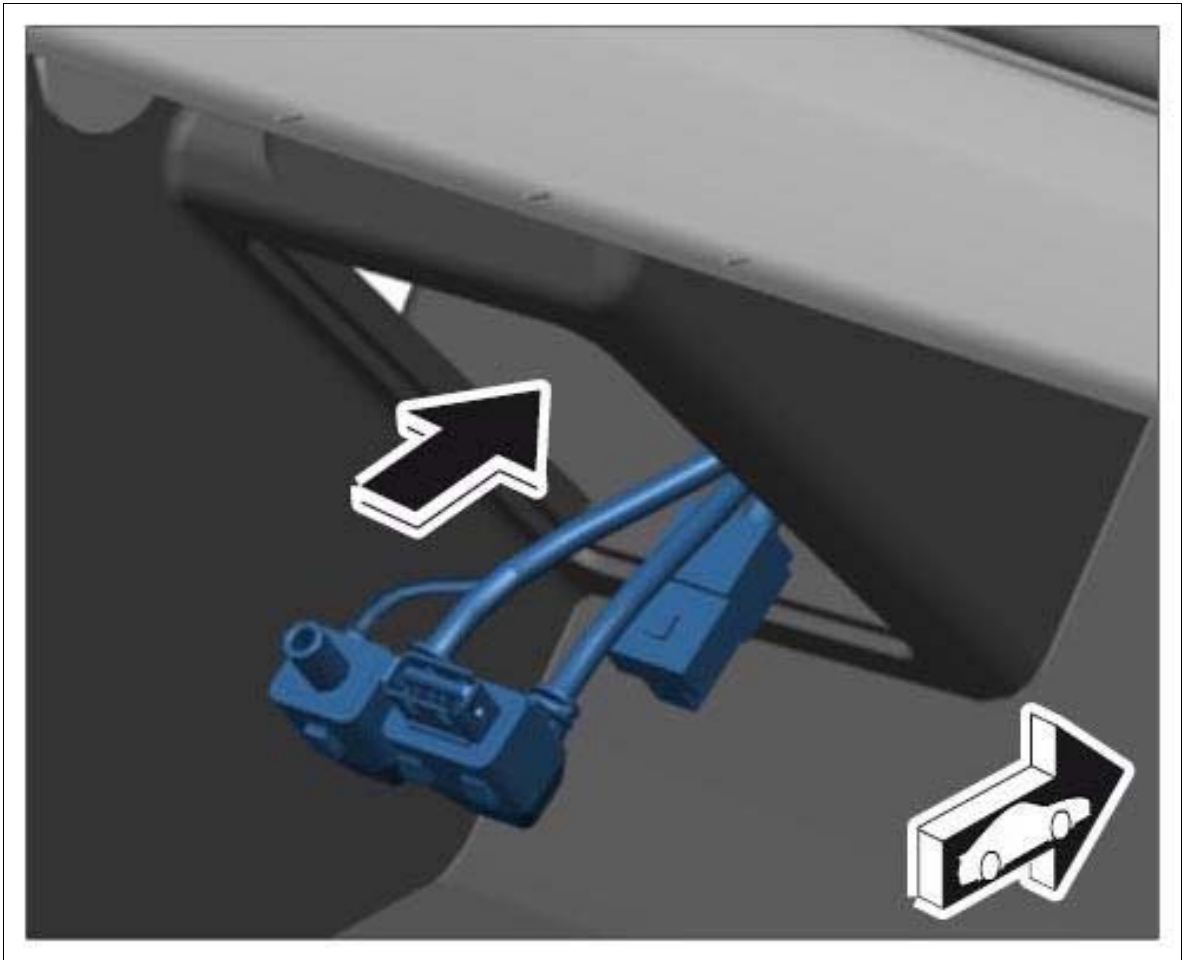
Fig 5: Disconnecting Plug Connection

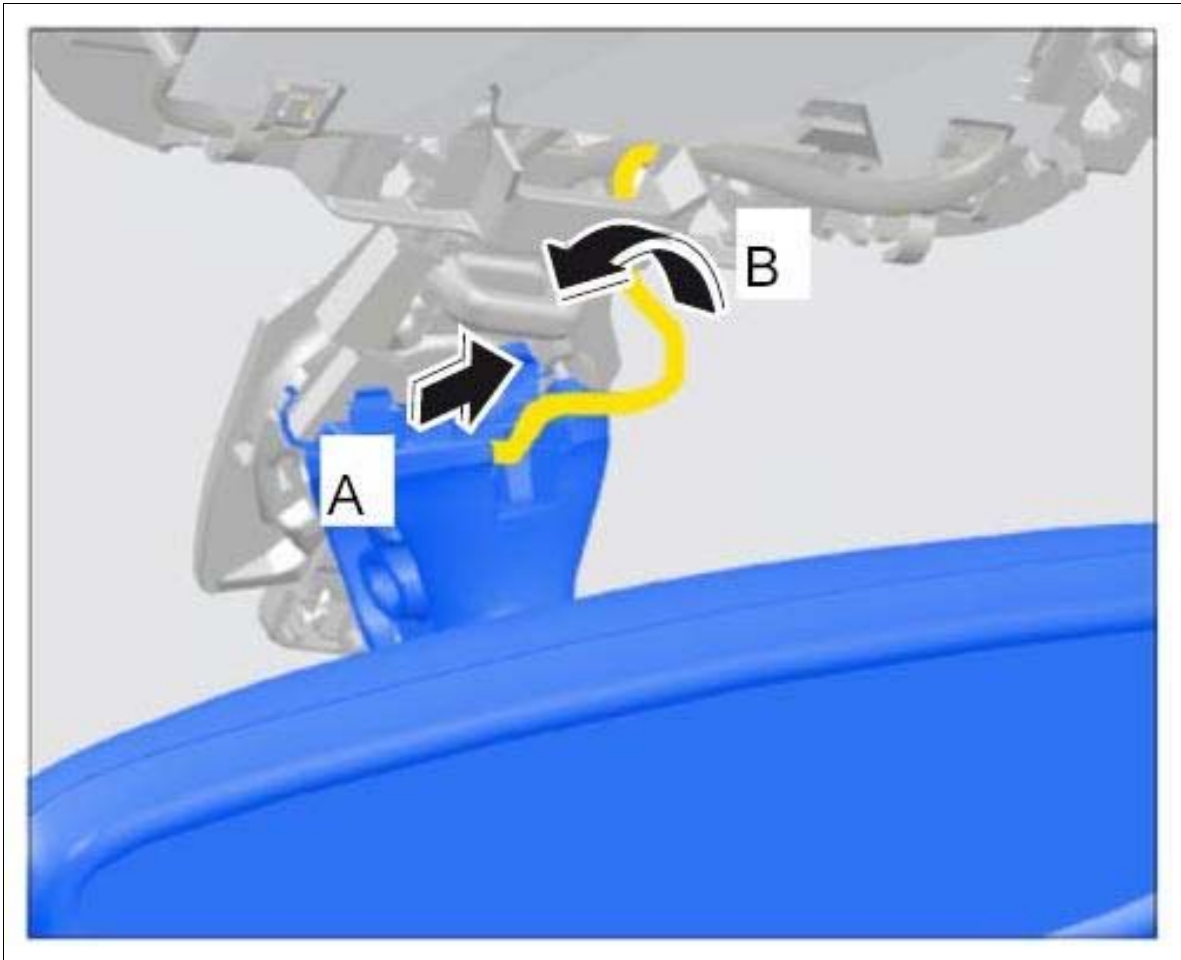

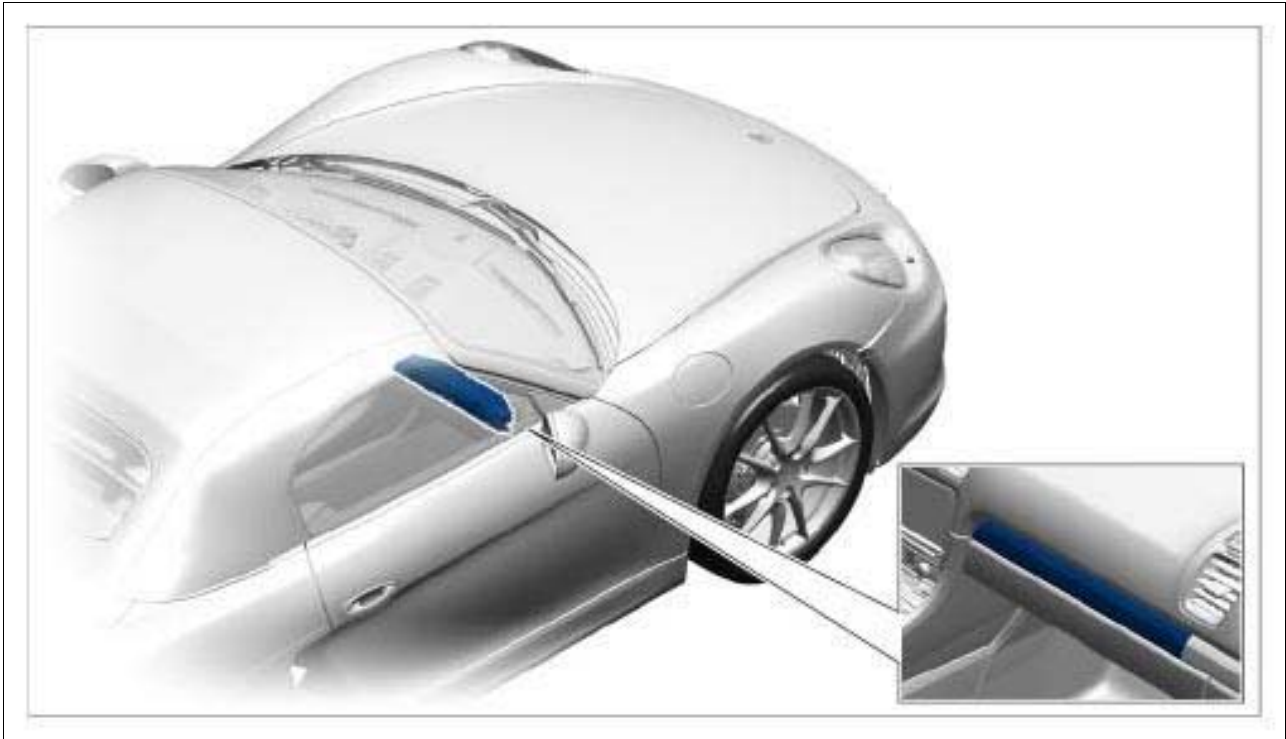

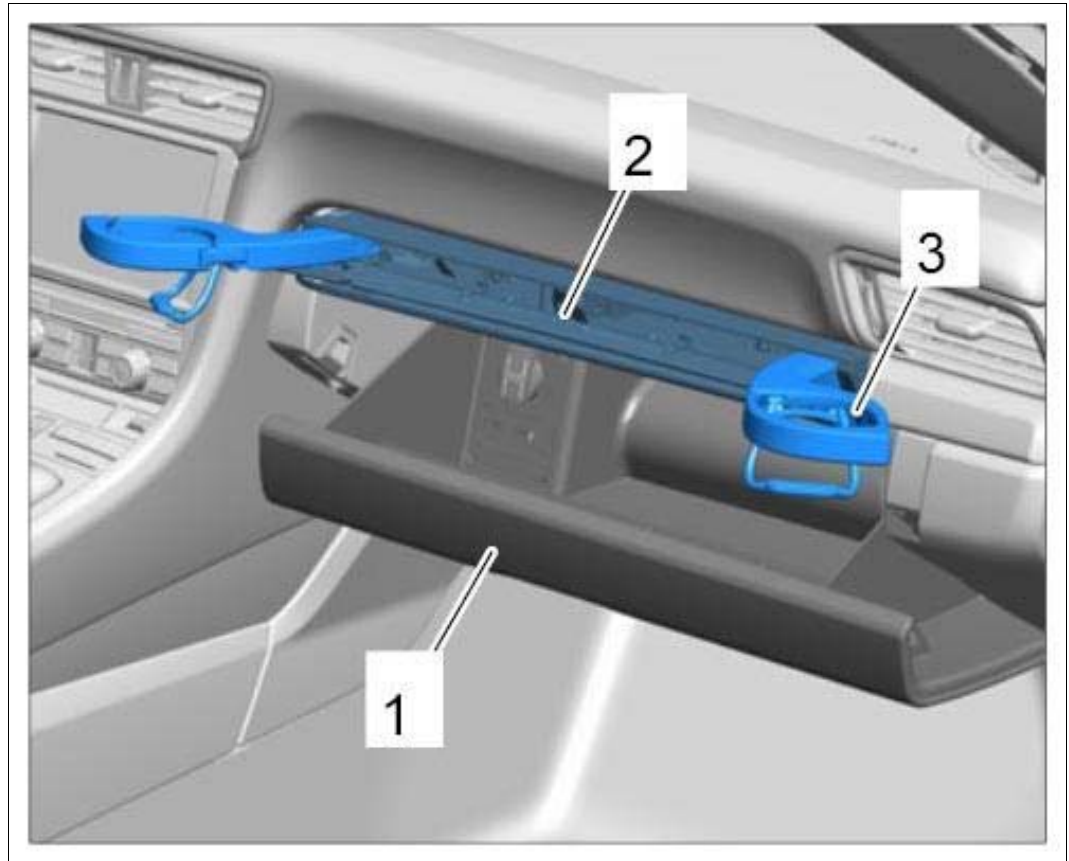
Fig 1: Identifying Cupholder Installation Position

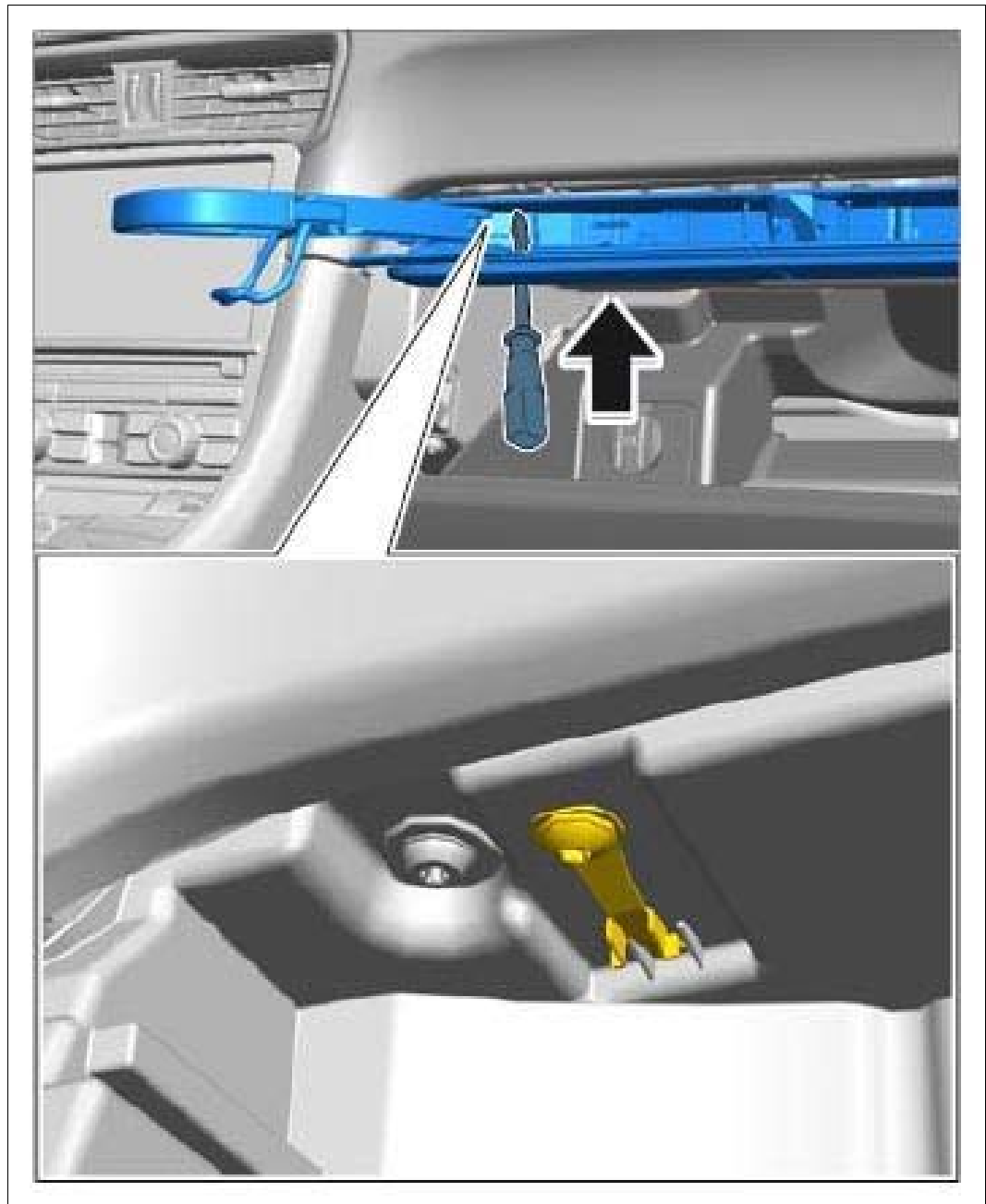

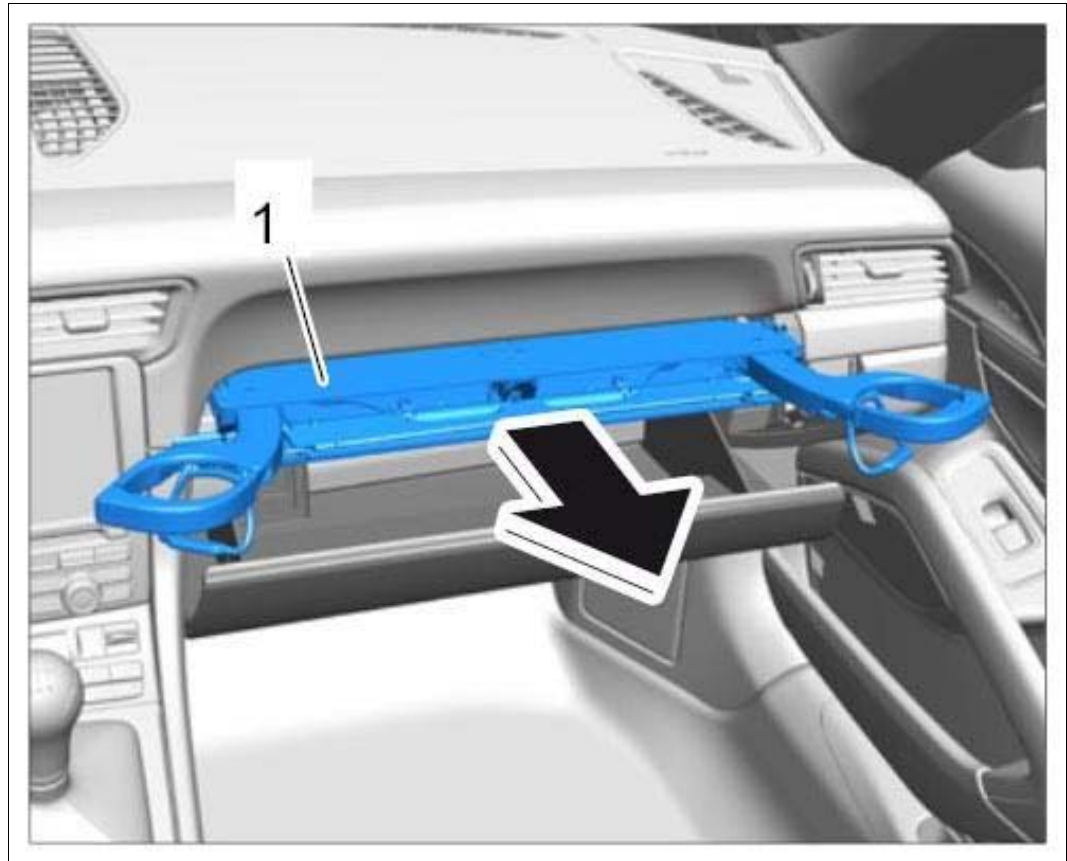

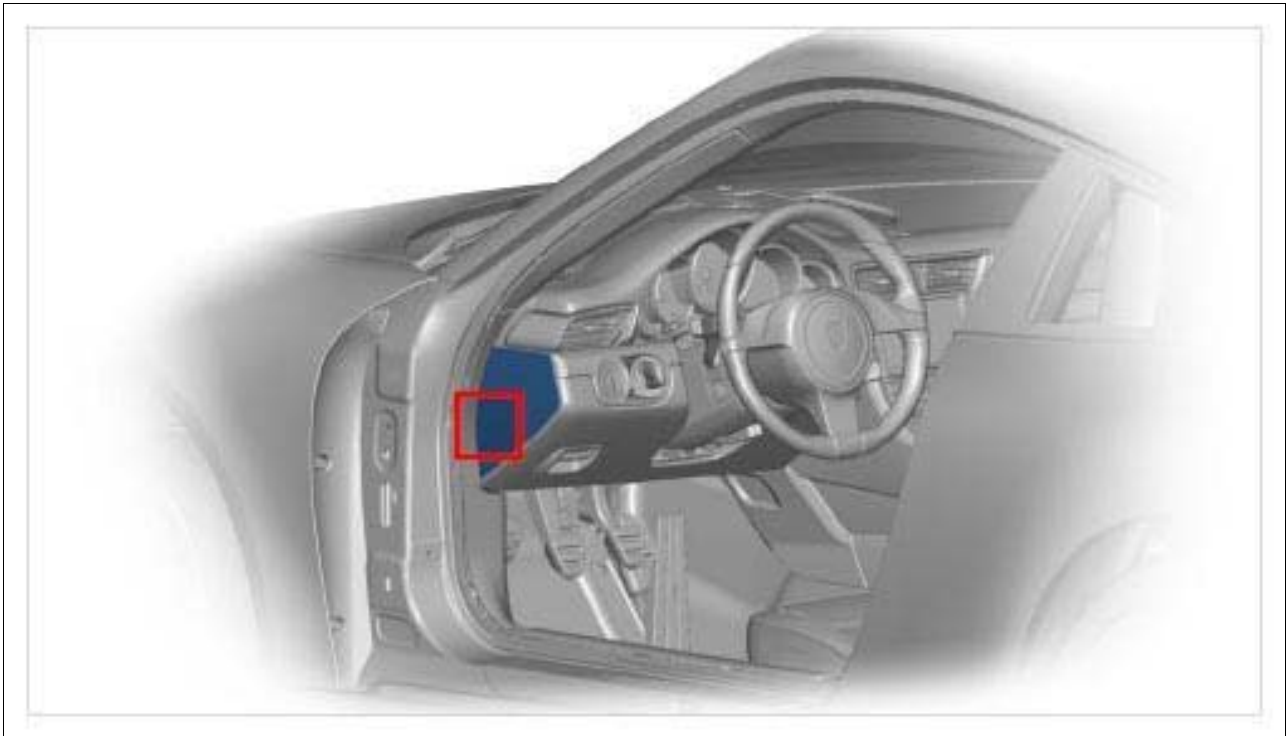

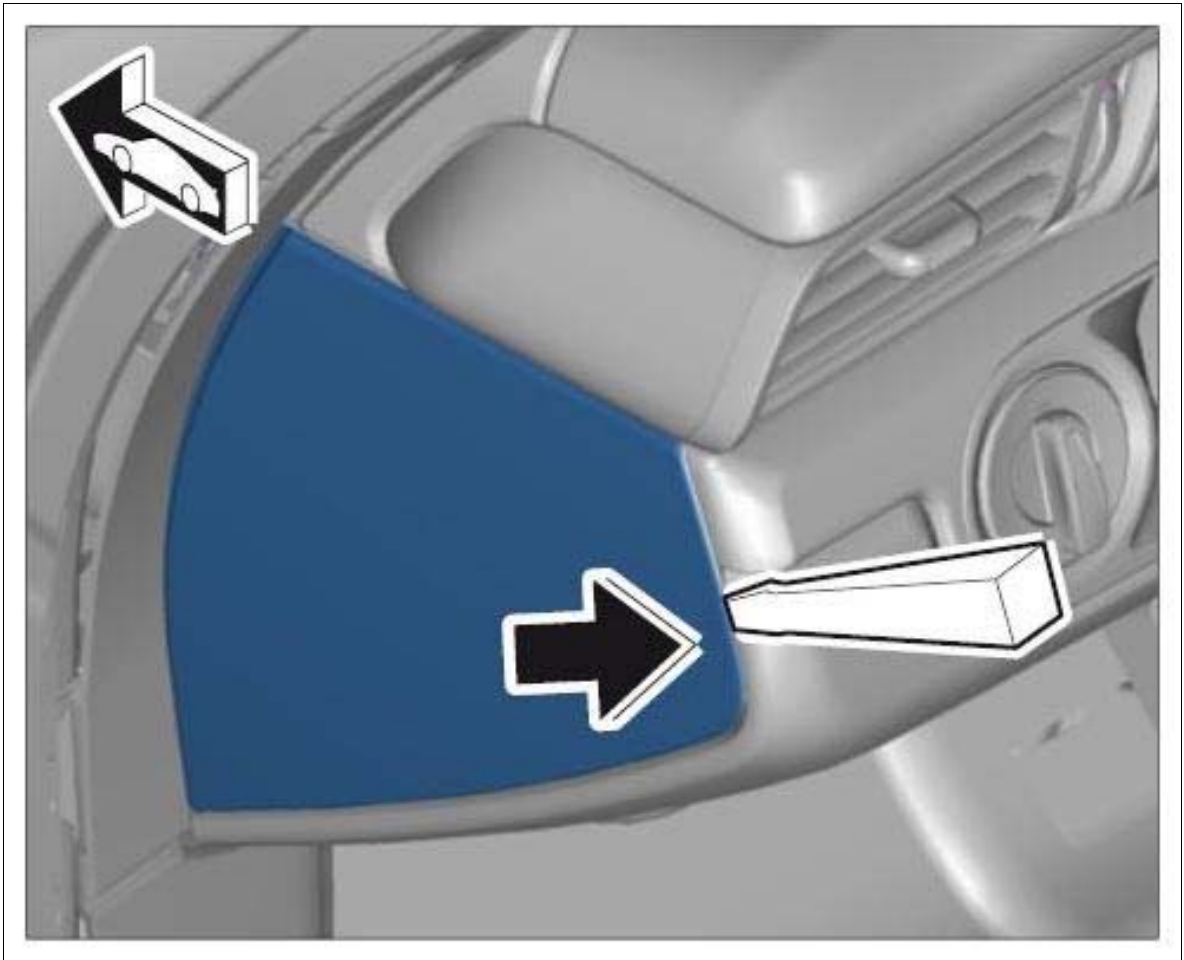
Fig 1: Identifying Dashboard Trim Panel Installation Position

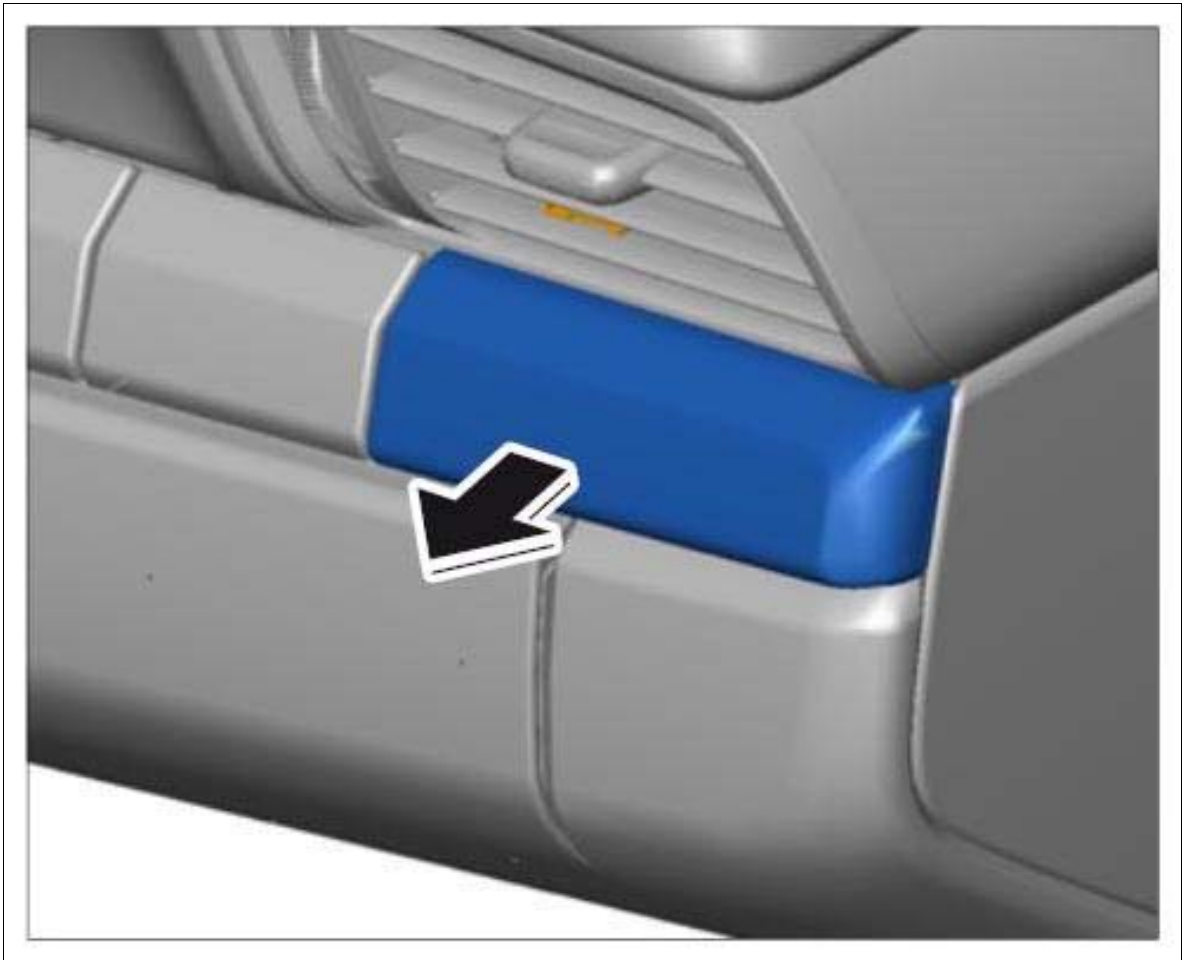

To reduce the unclipping forces and thereby the risk of damage during removal, the removal steps must be carried out at the accessible connection points using a suitable tool.
