When retrofitting 18 inch approved wheels and tires to **1995 911 Carrera Coupes after the above-mentioned VIN**, a support bracket must be installed on the mounting points of the steering rack housing. The support bracket is already installed on 1996 911 Carrera Coupes and Cabriolets.

Bracket Installation:

Between the steering rack mounting points, a support bracket and longer allen head bolts (arrows figure 1) must be installed before retrofit of approved 18 inch wheels and tires. The allen head bolts are torqued to 45 Nm (32.5 ft lbs).


