1	<p>Check passenger side airbag by simulation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Before working on this fault code, read through and follow the section below:</li> <li style="padding-left: 20px;"><b><u>69 63 19 REMOVING AND INSTALLING SIDE AIRBAG - AS OF MY 2003 (ALL MODELS)</u></b> , and <b><u>69 AW SAFETY REGULATIONS FOR HANDLING AIRBAGS AND... - AS OF MY 2003 (ALL MODELS)</u></b> for handling airbag and belt tensioner - vehicles</li> <li>• Switch ignition off and remove ignition key (if KESSY system is installed, pull off operating lever)</li> <li>• Disconnect negative terminal of vehicle battery and cover battery terminal with insulating material for safety.</li> <li>• Always wait at least 1 minute before doing any more work on the system</li> </ul>	Go to Step 2	
2	<p>Check passenger side airbag</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Commercially available tool: Use Additional airbag tester, Porsche set No. 169 and connect test box 5056/C with test cable 5056/3 in place of the passenger side airbag</li> <li>• Re-connect vehicle battery properly</li> <li>• Switch on ignition</li> <li>• Read out fault memory</li> <li>• Erase fault memory</li> <li>• Switch off ignition</li> <li>• Remove ignition key (if KESSY system is installed, pull off operating lever)</li> <li>• Switch on ignition</li> <li>• Read out fault memory</li> </ul>	Fault code is no longer detected Go to Step 4	Go to Step 3
3	<p>Check wiring harness for pinching or chafing damage</p>	No damage visible Go to Step 6	Replace wiring harness --> End
4	<p>Carry out visual inspection on 2-pin plug connection for passenger side airbag</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Switch off ignition</li> <li>• Check that the 2-pin plug connection for the passenger side airbag is connected and locked correctly</li> </ul>	Go to Step 5	Connect and lock plug connection properly --> End
