



PORSCHE FESTIVAL 2016

Seeking Registrations of Interest from Porsche Club Members to Participate

The Porsche Club of New Zealand, in partnership with the event organisers, are inviting all Porsche Club members to be part of the 2016 New Zealand Festival of Motor Racing Celebrating Porsche.

The Festival is New Zealand's largest historic motorsport event and takes place over two weekends in January at the Hampton Downs circuit in the North Waikato. The event will be held on **January 15-17 and January 22-24, in 2016.**

We are aiming to have a number of significant Porsche cars on display and in demonstrations, with 'works' Porsche drivers also in attendance.

A packed schedule of motor racing action on the circuit includes the Porsche Club Race Series, Porsche Classic Race Class, Porsche Endurance Race, and for road registered cars Regularity Trials and Dual Car Sprints.

Other race classes will include Formula 5000 and Historic Muscle Cars, as well as numerous other exciting single seater and tin-top classes.

We are planning car displays and a record attempt for the most Porsches gathered together in one place in New Zealand.

The purpose of this flyer is to advise Club members of the event and seek registrations of interest on what cars you would likely bring and what events you would like to participate in.

Your feedback is important to assist the Club and organisers in shaping the event. Read on for an overview of the activities planned for you to enjoy.

Porsche Club Member Participation

There will be an opportunity for all club members to participate with their road and race cars. Options for event entries are summarised below:

Porsche Race Car Entry Options:

Porsche Club Race Series: Races will be rounds in the 2015/16 Porsche Club Race Series. Entrants will need to be entered into the 2015/16 Porsche Club Race Series. All Porsche race cars are eligible to join the series for these rounds.

Classic Porsche Race Cars: The proposal is a grid of classic Porsche race cars up to model year 1997 (i.e. 993 and older). The aim of this race class is to provide demonstration races showcasing classic Porsche race cars. There are no modification or tyre rules, no special requirements other than a pre-1998 Porsche race car that meets the required safety standards.

1 Hour Endurance Race: We are proposing a 1hr endurance race on Sunday 24 January 2016. There is a lot of excitement and opinion on how this race would be structured. Options currently include a Pro/Am race, or a team's event with either car or driver changes. This race would be open to all Porsche race cars and we are actively seeking feedback from those who are interested in entering to understand what the grid may look like and driver's preference for car and/or driver swaps.

Porsche Road Car Club Sport Entry Options:

Modern Regularly Trials: Modern Regularly Trials are proposed in the first weekend and would consist of road registered only Porsches. This event is open to all Porsche club members, and all road registered Porsches (old and new) are welcome to enter. The minimum time bar is likely to be set around 1 minute 25 seconds, so will provide members the chance to circulate at a good pace.

Dual Car Circuit Sprints: Dual Car Sprints are suitable for members with road registered cars wishing to compete in a lower level motorsport event, and is ideally suited to experienced drivers who regularly participate in the Porsche Club Speed Series, organised advanced Driver Training and Track Day events.

Porsche Car Open Event Entry Options:

We are planning to ensure that we have a strong presence of Porsche's over the two weekends. We intend to have a dedicated area for members to park and a dedicated member area at the event.

The most Porsches gathered together in one place in NZ record: On Sunday 17 January 2016, the club is planning a record attempt for the most Porsches gathered together in one place in NZ. The goal is 250+ cars, and is open to all road and race Porsches. Once assembled and photos taken, the cars will do a few parade laps of the circuit.

Display of significant and rare NZ Porsche cars: Members are invited to display their rare Porsche cars. Please contact us with details if you think your car would qualify for this display.

Show and Shine Porsche Car displays: All members are welcome to display their cars in the Show and Shine (or Porsche Parking only) area, to be held every day of the festival event.
